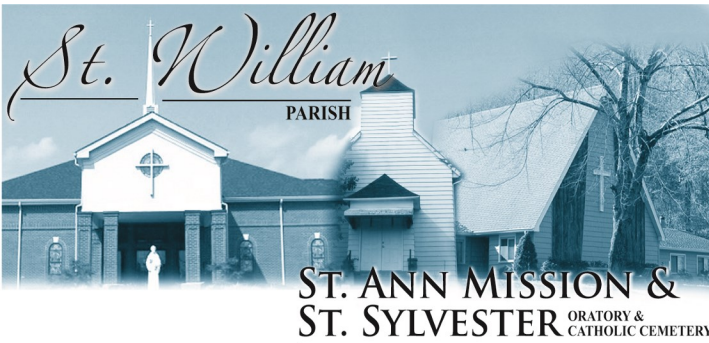

In matters of public policy that are not tied to either candidate or party, the Church is both legally permitted and duty bound to speak ... especially when those policies concern the dignity and sanctity of life.

On November 8th, Kentuckians will go to the polls once again. One of the choices facing them this year are two proposed amendments to our State Constitution. The second of these is of paramount importance, as it will explicitly affirm that the Kentucky Constitution contains no right to either abortion or its governmental funding.

The Kentucky Catholic Bishops are therefore strongly encouraging all Kentuckians to go to the polls on election day this year, turn over their ballots and vote 'YES' for Amendment #2 which is located at the very bottom of the back page. A "YES" vote on Amendment #2 is a vote for life! More information is available in the back of Church or on the website YesforLifeKY.com.
