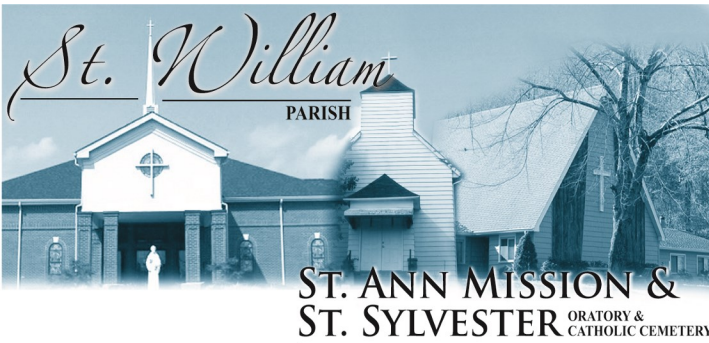

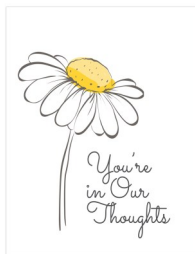
Parish News:
