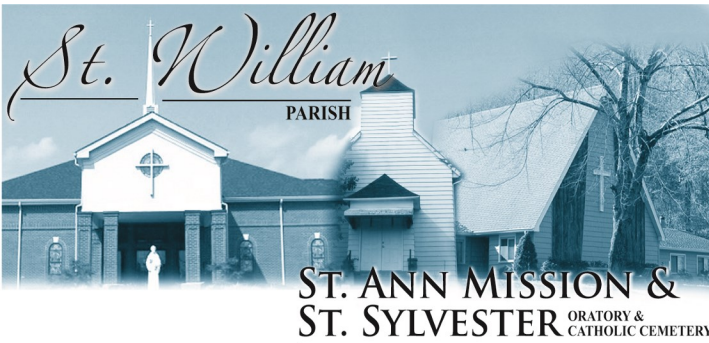

ST. WILLIAM MISSION STATEMENT

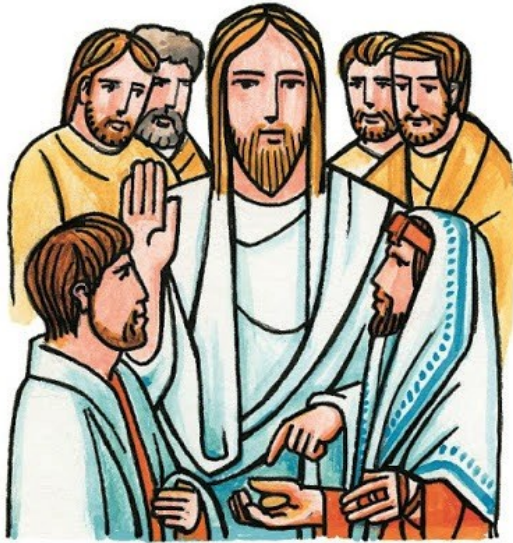
