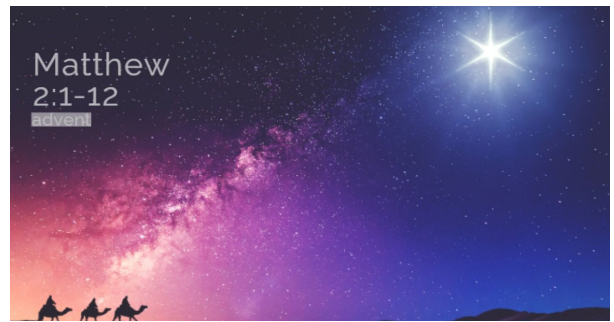
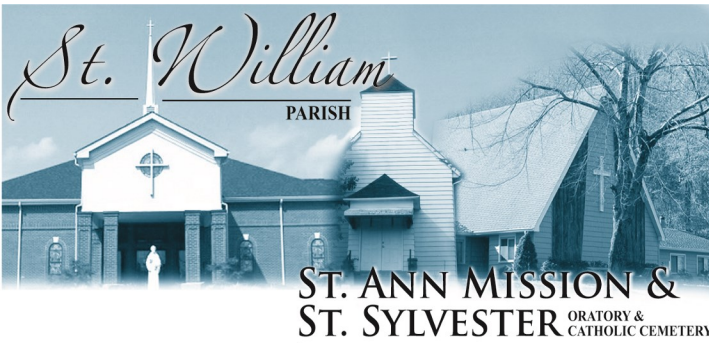

*Bulletin Letter – January 5th –**Epiphany Sunday*

Following both the bright star in the Western Sky and centuries of Wisdom from their tradition, the Magi traveled from distant lands to search for the newborn King. What had been revealed to only a few nearby shepherds had now been made manifest to people from foreign nations.

Journey's play in a prominent role in the role of the readings for Epiphany. Isaiah describes the day when caravans from near and far will be drawn to a radiant Jerusalem. The psalmist tells of Kings from most distant nations will come to pay homage to the Messiah.

Paul insists that the gentiles are invited into the same body with the same promise of Salvation. The letter from Matthew is telling of the Magi's long Journey to see the newborn king. Let us listen to God's word, aware that we too make our personal journey to the Lord.

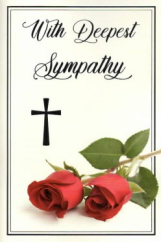

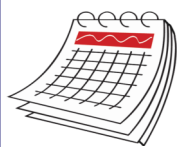
