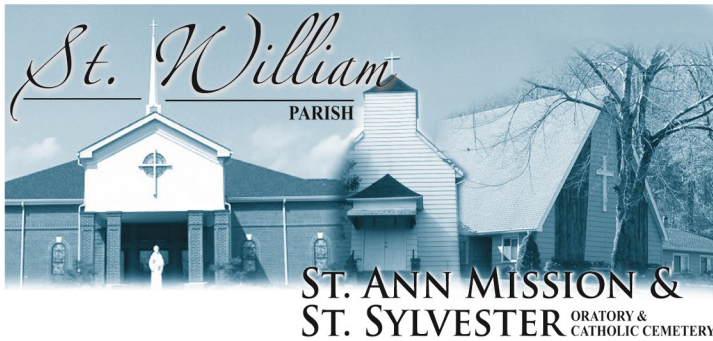


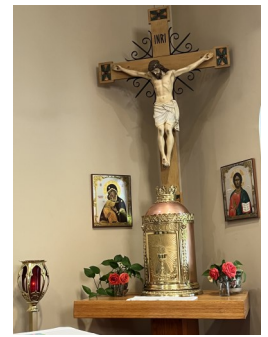

1. **What are the conditions for Divine Mercy Sunday?** - Celebrate the Feast the Sunday after Easter -Sincerely repent of all our sins. -Place our complete trust in Jesus.— Go to Confession, preferably before this feast. -Receive Holy Communion on the day of this Feast.
  2. **What is the prayer for Divine Mercy?** Lord, I desire to trust in your divine mercy to extend that there is no doubt in my heart and mind that you will bestow upon me this precious gift of love. Help one to trust in your mercy because of your intimate goodness. Jesus, I love you and trust in you. Amen.
  3. **Why do we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday?** Divine Mercy Sunday focuses on the gift of mercy and love given through Christ's death, burial and resurrection. As Pope John Paul II stated, Divine Mercy reaches human beings through the heart of Christ crucified.
  4. **When is Divine Mercy Sunday?** Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter, which concludes the Octave of Easter. 5. How do we celebrate the Feast of Divine Mercy? *The whole parish family comes together on April 27, 2025 – Second Sunday of Easter at St. William Catholic Church. 9:30 am to 10:30 am – Public Eucharistic Adoration reciting the Divine Mercy Chaplet meditating the five wounds of Jesus, repenting of all our Sins!*
