This obligation does not apply to those who are ill, those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility, or those with serious underlying health conditions.

PARKING AT ST. AIDAN

As you are aware the number of parking spaces is limited at St. Aidan. The parking lot at the rear of the Upper School and the one on Dover Street are available on weekends

and when school is closed. The Lower School has an area that is designated a children's play area. For safety reasons please do not park there. People with disabilities may park in the three reserved parking spaces in front of the rectory on Willis Ave. This special area is needed for church access by people who use wheelchairs and specially-equipped vehicles. Thank you for being parking considerate.

HOSPITALITY SUNDAY

St. Aidan invites you to join fellow parishioners after Mass in St. Francis Garden or Kirwin Hall for hospitality, one Sunday each month. All parish groups are invited to host one hospitality event. If your group is interested in facilitating Hospitality Sunday in November or December, please contact the rectory with your preferred date and time.

BAPTISM

To arrange a baptism contact the rectory office. Forms need to be completed giving information on the parents, child's date and place of birth, as well as the names and religious affiliation of the sponsors. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic. Baptisms are held on the 1st Sunday and 3rd Sunday at 1:30 PM. To hold a private baptism you must make arrangements with a priest or deacon to perform the baptism. Private baptisms are held on Saturday or Sunday when the church is available. First time parents are required to attend a Baptism Class. Classes are held in the church on the second Sunday of the month after the 12 PM Mass. Parents are asked to gather at St. Joseph's statue to the right of the altar.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements are to be made at the Rectory office at least 9 months in advance. Pre-Cana and FOCCUS registrations must be arranged. St. Aidan's Pre-Cana Class consists of a Four Week parish program that is held on a weeknight, (Wednesday) from 7:30pm to 9:30pm. The Pre-Cana Class Fee is \$90.00 payable to: Church of St Aidan. ARE YOU SEARCHING?

Are you searching for a faith to follow? Do you know someone who may be interested in learning more about what the Catholic Church believes and teaches? Were you baptized as an infant but not raised in the faith or raised in another Christian faith? Whatever your situation, wherever you are in your faith journey, OCIA (formerly RCIA) is here for YOU. OCIA stands for Order of Christian Initiation for Adults. It is a process by which adults can inquire about the Catholic Church. There is never any pressure put on any inquirer to become a Catholic. If an inquirer or seeker decides to move closer toward becoming a Catholic, he/she receives instruction in a small setting guided by a team of dedicated parishioners. The inquirer decides if he/she wants to move forward one step at a time. The whole parish family supports this process through prayer and witness. Those who choose to become Catholic are welcomed into the Church through the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. THE GLORIA

In those days, the princes said to the king: "Jeremiah ought to be put to death; he is demoralizing the soldiers who are left in this city, and all the people, by speaking such things to them; he is not interested in the welfare of our people, but in their ruin." King Zedekiah answered: "He is in your power"; for the king could do nothing with them. And so they took Jeremiah and threw him into the cistern of Prince Malchiah, which was in the quarters of the guard, letting him down with ropes. There was no water in the cistern, only mud, and Jeremiah sank into the mud. Ebed-melech, a court official, went there from the palace and said to him: "My lord king, these men have been at fault in all they have done to the prophet Jeremiah, casting him into the cistern. NICENE CREED

What's Pastor Thinking

What's that Jesus said again! 'I came to cast fire on the earth and how I wish it were already kindled.' Not what you expect from the gentle Good Shepherd, the Prince of Peace. Prince of Division, more likely! What's that all about?

What Jesus is saying is that once His message gets into households, into people's lives, into society, it will bring a radical change. Families will divide over it, just as the prophets had foretold. Corrupt regimes will fall. Christian values challenge our politic, values, morals and so will divide people one from another. At the time of Jesus the Roman occupation and the oppressive regime of Herod dominated the

region. The wealthy and arrogant high priests in Jerusalem and the false agendas of the Pharisees turned people away from knowing the truth. However he tells them this is the moment all Israel's history has been waiting for. A change is possible if you turn towards the Lord and heed His message.

As history unfolded, Jesus warning about change on the horizon went unheeded. In AD 70 Israel ended up paying the very last penny as the Romans destroyed Jerusalem..

We might well ask today, what relevance have these warnings for people who live nearly two thousand years after they all came true?

Well the church has from early on read this chapter as a warning that each generation must read the signs of the times, the great movements of people,

governments, nations and policies, and must react accordingly. If the kingdom of God is to come on earth as it is in heaven, part of the prophetic role of the church is to understand the events of earth and to seek to address them with the message of heaven. And if, like Jesus, we find that we seem to be bringing division, and that we ourselves become caught up in the crisis, so be it. What else would we expect?

Maybe today is our time to wake up. To look at the problems of the nation and to wake up and step up. God had a plan for humanity and we need to listen to it because when we turn away from God only destruction follows.

Jesus says: 'I came to cast fire on the earth and how I wish it were already kindled.' Enkindle in us Lord the fire of your love.

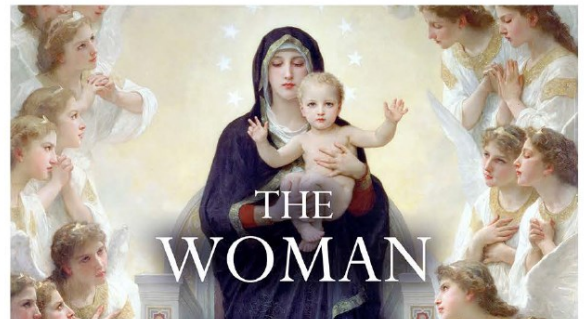
