





Assumption BVM Catholic School participates in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP), which means eligible students who reside in Wisconsin can attend catholic school <u>tuition-free</u>. Families who are eligible for WPCP are **exempt** from all tuition responsibilities: tuition fees, registration fees, Third Source Funding and Service Hours.

To meet the income requirements for the program, a student's family must have an adjusted gross income at or below 220% of the federal poverty level. The **adjusted gross income** can be found on line 11 of your 2023 Federal Income Tax Form (1040). Here are the 2024-2025 income guidelines:

Family Size	Single Family	Married Family
2	\$43,384	
3	\$54,692	<mark>\$61,692</mark>
4	\$66,000	<mark>\$73,000</mark>
5	\$77,308	<mark>\$84,308</mark>
<u>6</u>	\$88,616	<mark>\$95,616</mark>

*For each additional family member add \$11,308.

Family Eligibility

- ➤ Current WPCP families can register any current 4K through Sixth grade students and must meet the eligibility requirements.
- Current Assumption BVM School students, *not* previously part of WPCP, who are entering 4K, 5K, and First Grade only can register, and must meet the eligibility requirements.
- New families considering Assumption BVM School and who attended public school, can register students in any grade, 4K through sixth, and must meet the eligibility requirements.

When to Apply

- Families need to apply online in order to participate.
- > Applications will be accepted from February 1 through April 18, 2024.
- ➤ The state of WI DPI (Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction) will **not** accept late applications *for any reason*.



How to Apply

- 1. Complete the online application.
 - a) Click here for the Online Parent Application: https://sms.dpi.wi.gov/ChoiceParent/
 - b) An email address is required to use the online application.
- 2. Provide proof of residency to the Assumption BVM School Office.
 - a) Proof of residency paperwork can be a utility bill, cable bill or landline phone bill (cell phone bills are not accepted).
 - b) This paperwork must show the parent's name and correct mailing address.
 - c) This paperwork must be current and dated within three months of the application period.
- 3. Provide income documentation to the Assumption BVM School Office. This is <u>only</u> <u>needed</u> if a child is **new** to the program. Example ~ student entering 4K.
 - a) Income documentation can be a copy of your most recent taxes or W2.

Note: The application and all documents must be received in the Assumption BVM School office by April 18, 2024.

- 4. Complete the *school* Online Registration Form to <u>secure a spot</u> for your child(ren) in each grade registering.
 - a) Click here to complete the form. https://abvmeducation.org/online-registration-form-preparation
 - b) Enter all fields.
 - c) At the bottom of the form click the Pay Later button. WPCP families are exempt from all tuition responsibilities (tuition fees, registration fees, Third Source Funding and Service Hours).
