FAITHFUL NAVIGATOR'S MESSAGE

Sir Knights,

Here's quick summary of a number of items that will be discussed over the next few months at our monthly assembly meetings.

During the last three or four months, we have discussed investing a portion of the money that we currently have invested in CD's into bonds. We'd like to earn 6 or 7% returns instead of the less than 1% return that we are currently earning. I have sent a request to transfer \$10,000 from Cd's to bonds to our State Advocate. If he approves the transfer, he will forward our request to Supreme to get their approval. If approved by Supreme, we'll be discussing how we can invest these funds. Hopefully, we'll be making a decision before the end of this fraternal year.

In the next few months, we will be starting the selection of new officers for our assembly. In March, I will select a nominating officer who in April and May will be requesting for our Sir Knights to nominate individuals for the different officer positions in our Assembly. All Sir Knights are eligible to nominate individual for these officer position, as well as, to be nominated. In June, we will be holding the election for our officers who will then take their positions as of July 1st.

In April, our Faithful Purser will be presenting a budget for our next fraternal year. Discussions will be held in May and June. The budget will be voted on during our June meeting. This budget should be accepted before the beginning of the next fraternal year.

Please attend our meeting and participate in determining our finances and in the selection of our new officers. We want and need your assistance.
