Sts. Simon and Jude were Apostles and appear in the Gospels. St. Simon was one of the 12 with Jesus throughout his ministry and in the upper room at Pentecost! St. Jude Thaddeus was also an apostle and cousin of Jesus. The statue in our Narthex with the red votive candles is San Judas Tadeo, the "patron saint of lost causes." His writings encourage us to persevere, even in the most desperate circumstances. Sts. Simon and Jude share a feast day because they were both martyred in Persia before their relics were buried in St. Peter's in Rome. Sts. Simon and Jude, pray for us!
