Consider these questions as you watch this week's episode:

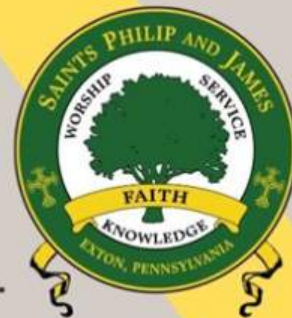
Knowing about Jesus is different than having a personal relationship with Jesus. What's the difference?

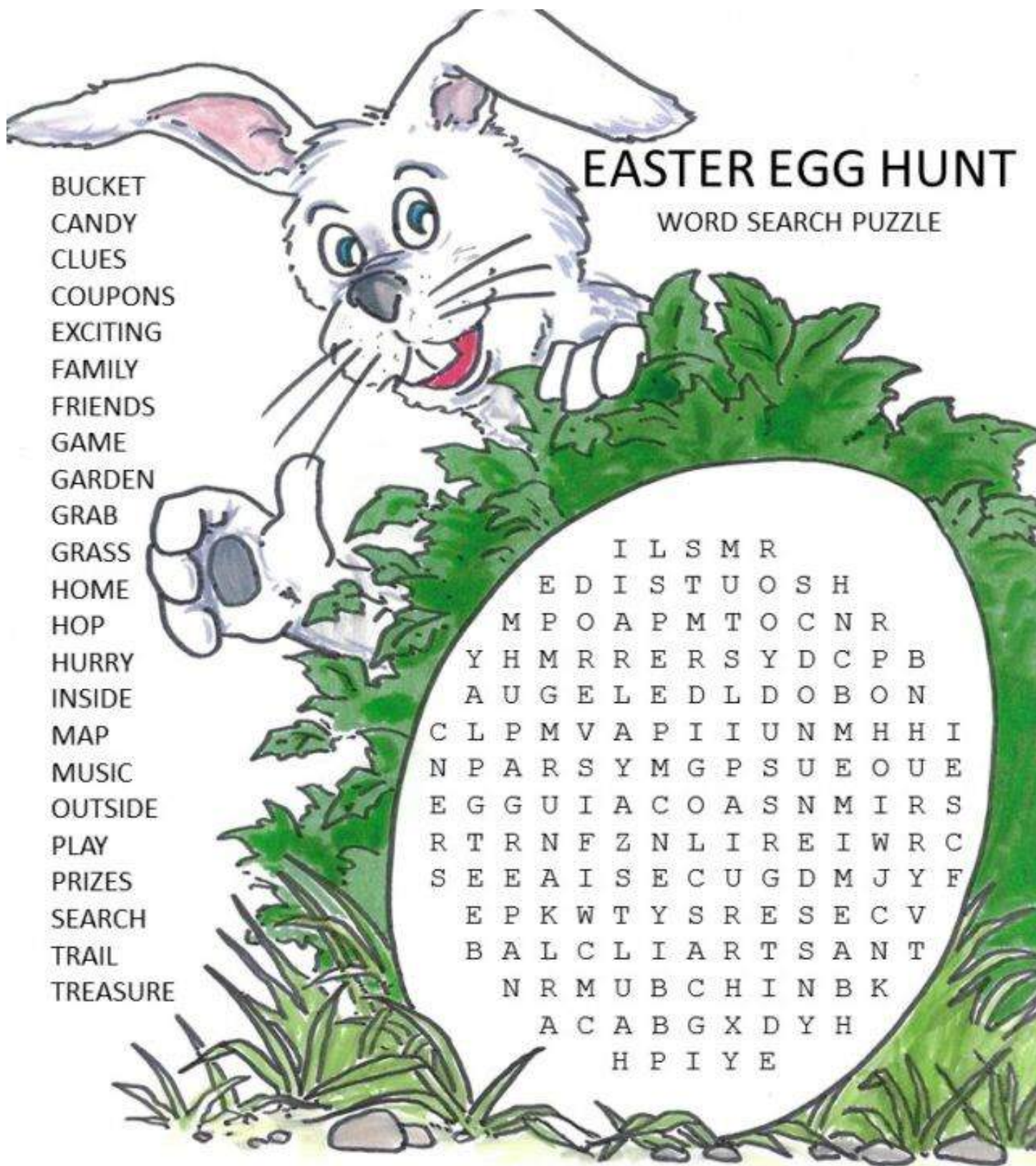

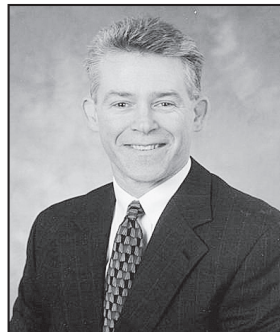
