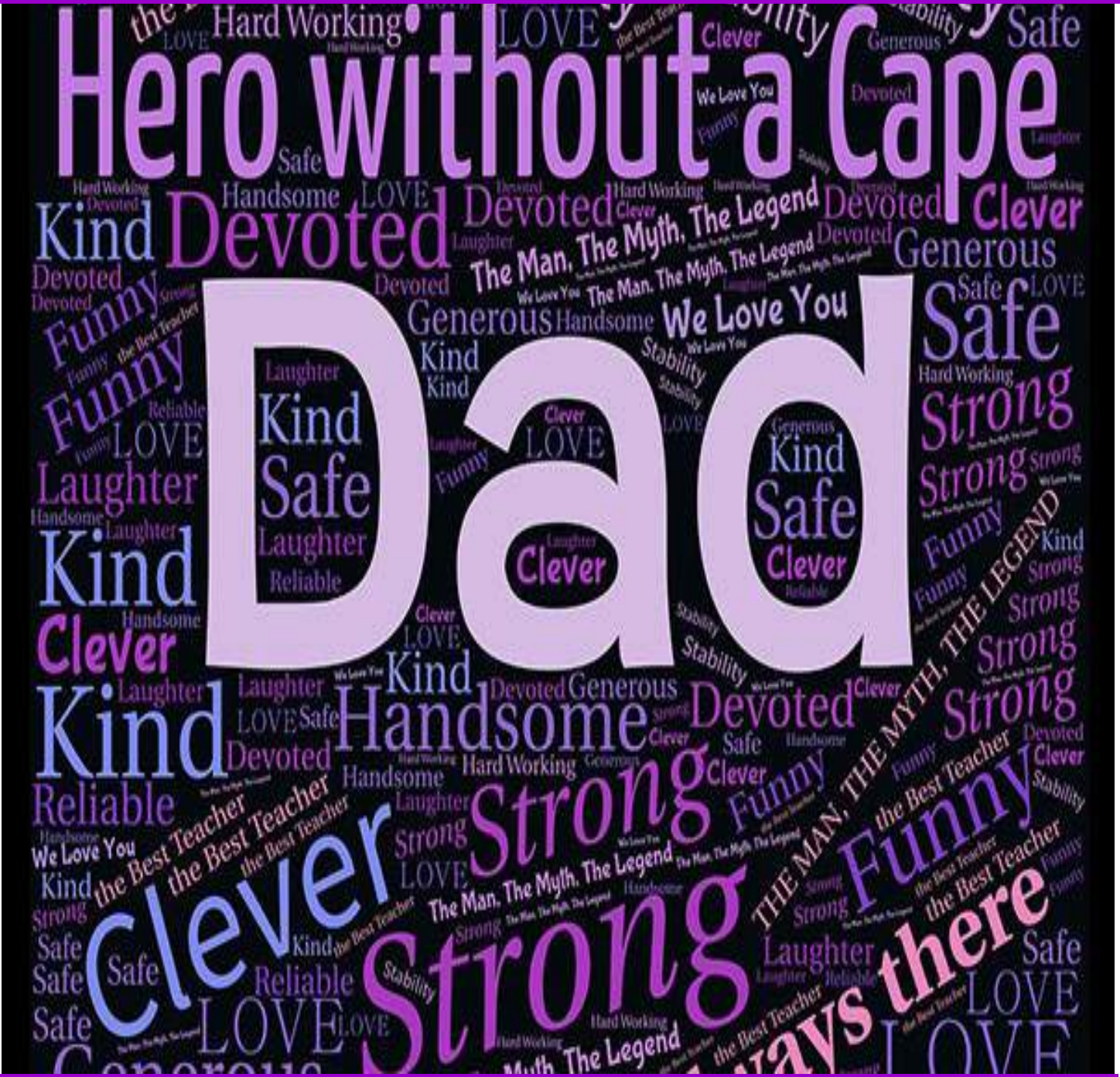

Pastor's Corner



Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

What a wonderful day to honor our earthly fathers. Happy Father's Day to all our wonderful dads. As is noted in the Baptismal Ceremony, with their wives, fathers are the first teachers of their children in the ways of the Faith. The Church prays, on that occasion, that they also be the best of teachers. This is better done by example rather than words. May the good Lord bless our deceased fathers with eternal life and strengthen all living fathers to imitate the goodness of our Heavenly Father. +jcd

During this past February, SSPJ Parish and School completed an Agreed Upon Procedures (AUP) review, a process that occurs every two years at all Parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. The AUP is a review of the Parish and School finances by an outside accounting firm. The findings of the AUP are reported to the Pastor, School Principal, School Board Chair, Parish Finance Council, Business Manager and Archdiocese. The review period was for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2022 and the calendar year ended December 31, 2022. The AUP engagement was performed by Baker Tilly US, LLP which is the same firm that performed our reviews for the fiscal years ended June 30, 2017 and June 30, 2019. Prior to the review, Internal Control Questionnaires were completed and submitted to Baker Tilly for both Parish and School. The findings and recommendations were reviewed and accepted at our May 25th Parish Finance Council meeting and follow up actions have been documented.

We are pleased to report that the two key income tests continue to recognize the strength of our internal controls and processes. Church Income, as tested among bank deposits, the income statement and parish donor base came in at 99.8%. Tuition Income, as tested among our rate schedule, billing system, bank deposits and the income statement was also scored at 99.8%.

SSPJ will provide a reply to the Archdiocesan Office for Parish Services and Support that will address all findings and recommendations for strengthening internal controls and operating efficiency. Our reply has been signed by both Matt Burns, Parish Finance Council Chair and Pat Folan, School Board Chair.

As we continue the two-year cycle, our next review will occur in March 2025 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024. It is our hope that our financial communication, as reflected in our Annual Parish Update and Financial Report and Weekly Stewardship Report, provides all Parishioners with an understanding of the funds that are entrusted to our Parish and School.

REPEAT ITEM

We have been advised by the township that work will commence this month on the construction of the South portion of the "couplet" that will extend from the Chester Valley Trail on Ship Road to Rt 30. When completed the Ship Road adjacent to our campus will be one way North. There will be a crossover at our existing driveway providing access to both South bound Ship Road as well as access to our parking lot from the North. As more details become available we will continue to update in the bulletin and on our web site. Current schedule is for completion in November.

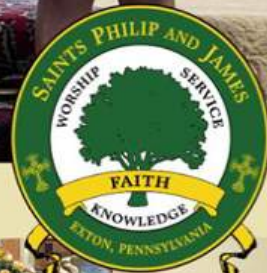

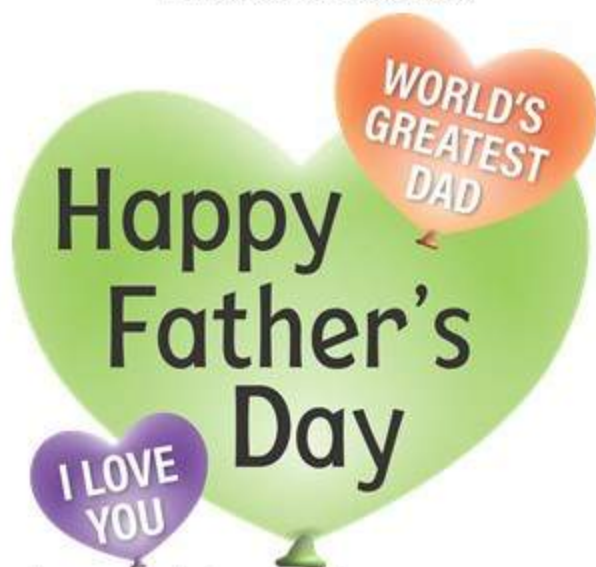

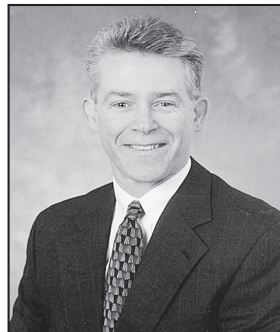
