## **Ship Road Detour Notice**

### Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

We have been advised that on or about September 25<sup>th</sup> **Ship Road southbound** from Swedesford\_Road to Lincoln Highway (Route 30) will be closed to all traffic.

Detour signs will be posted to direct School and Church traffic as follows:

Traveling south on Ship Road

Turn right on Swedesford Road

Turn left on Pottstown Pike (Route 100)

Turn left on Lincoln Highway (Route 30)

Turn left on Ship Road

Turn right in to SSPJ Campus

Please note that **Ship Road northbound** from Lincoln Highway to Swedesford Road will remain open during the detour period.


