Eucharistic Revival

The Catholic Church in America is currently in the second year of a three-year National Eucharistic Revival. Year two is focused on Parish Renewal. In support of this Revival, SS Philip & James Parish is presenting a four-week study beginning in October called "The Presence" produced by the Augustine Institute. The study will be held in the Rectory Meeting Room and includes small group break-out sessions with questions and answers and a participant study guide. 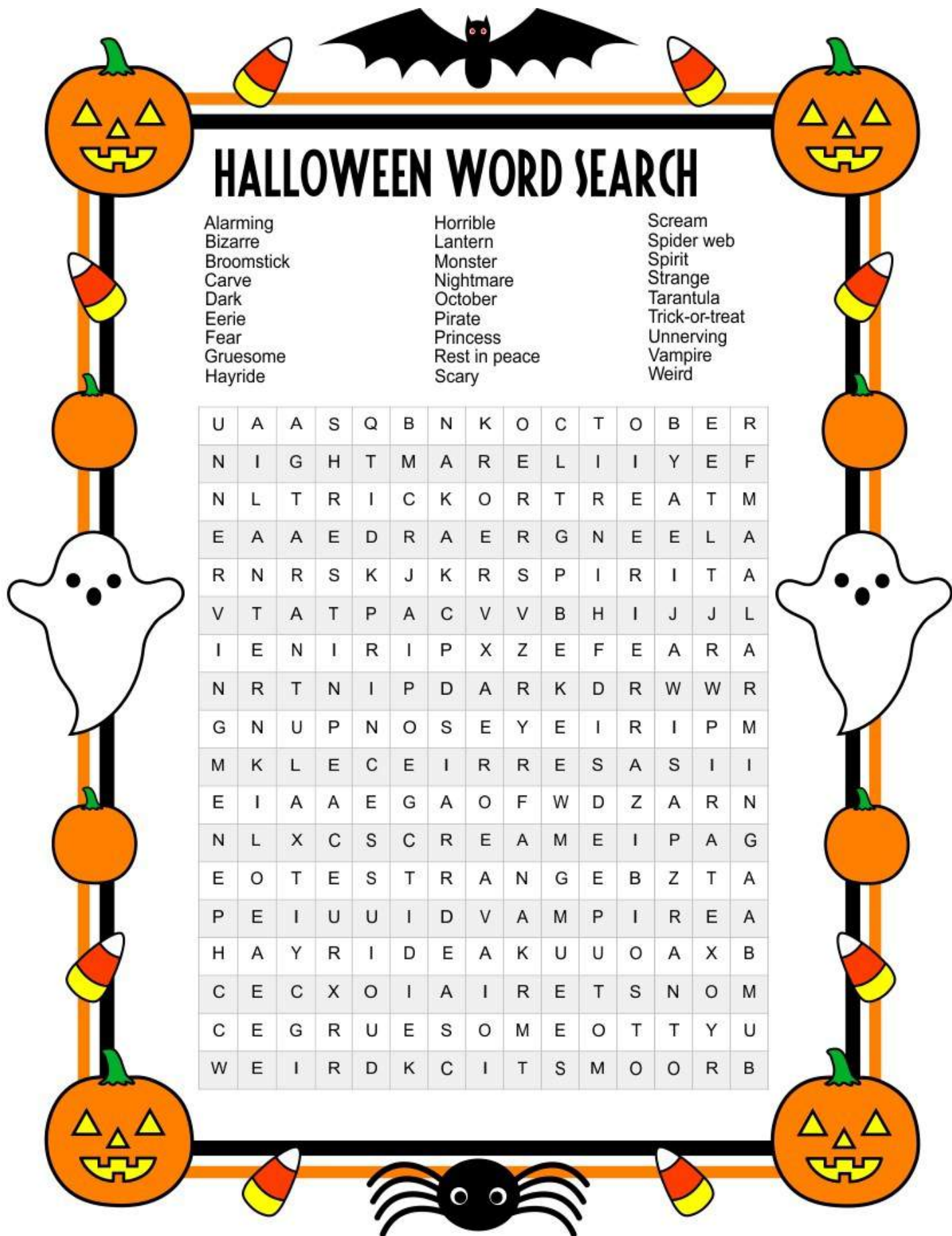

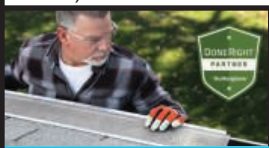

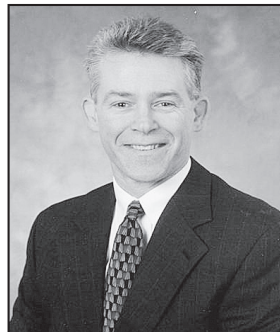
