Named for the second United States Secretary of Education, Terrel H. Bell, the Bell Award honors school leaders who are committed to education as a powerful and liberating force in people's lives. Principals are nominated by their school communities during the final stages of the National Blue Ribbon Schools application process.

Last month Saints Philip and James School, was selected as part of the 2023 cohort of National Blue Ribbon Schools. They are three of only 353 total schools and among just 40 private schools selected nationally. The schools were chosen for this honor based on exemplary high performance.




