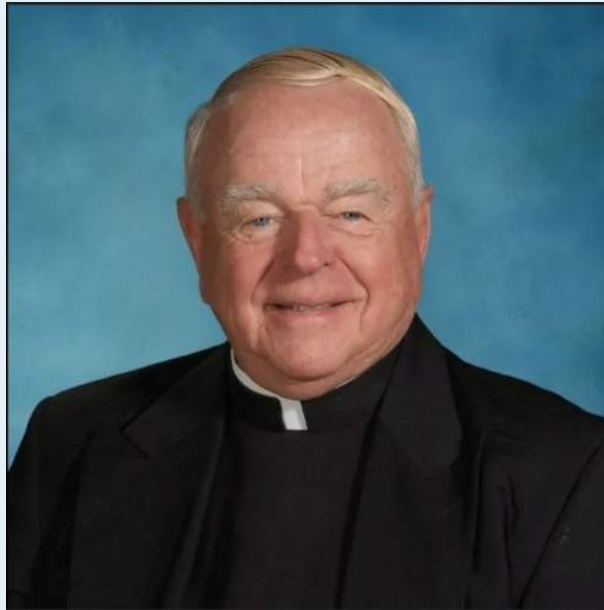
Sacrament of Matrimony

As you prepare to enter this well deserved retirement, we want to take a moment to express our deepest gratitude for your 17 years of faithful service to SSPJ parish.

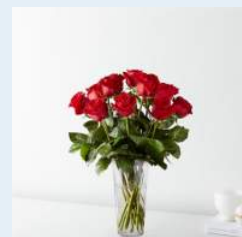

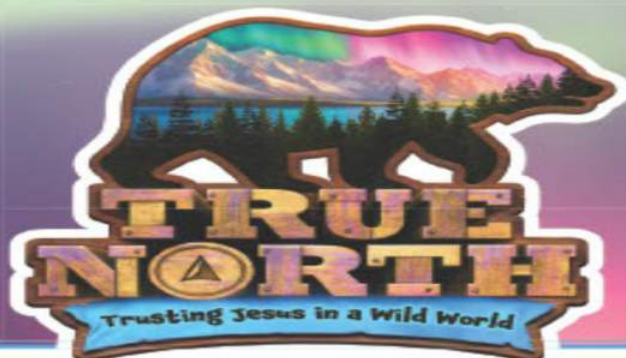

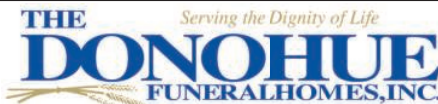
