Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As we gather with family and friends to celebrate Thanksgiving, it is important to remember that gratitude is not simply a polite gesture or a seasonal tradition—it is at the very heart of our faith. Scripture reminds us, “Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you” (1 Thessalonians 5:18).




