Dear Parish Family,

Ordinary Time often slips by quietly, overshadowed by the great feasts and fasts of the Church year. Yet this season offers something profoundly important: the reminder that God is not only present in the extraordinary moments but also in the steady rhythm of our daily lives.

Most of our days are not spent on mountaintops. They unfold in routines, responsibilities, and relationships. Ordinary Time teaches us to look for God right there—in the conversations we have, the work we do, the people we serve, and the choices we make when no one is watching. It invites us to cultivate a spirituality of attentiveness, where even the smallest act of love becomes a place where grace takes root.

This season also calls us to widen our prayer beyond ourselves. As we move through these ordinary days, the world continues to ache for peace. Conflicts persist, divisions deepen, and too many lives are touched by violence and fear. Ordinary Time becomes a sacred opportunity to recommit ourselves to praying for peace—peace in our homes, peace in our communities, and peace among nations. As we reflect on this call, the legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. stands before us with renewed clarity. His life reminds us that the pursuit of justice, reconciliation, and nonviolence is not reserved for special seasons—it is the work of every day. Dr. King understood that peace is not merely the absence of conflict but the presence of justice, compassion, and understanding. His witness challenges us to let our ordinary days be marked by extraordinary courage and love.

So as we journey through this season, may we embrace the quiet holiness of the everyday. May we pray earnestly for peace. May we allow the example of Dr. King to inspire us toward deeper compassion and steadfast hope. And may we discover that when we walk faithfully with God in the ordinary, our lives become anything but ordinary.


