Dear Parish Family,

On this Third Sunday of Easter, we once again hear the story of the Road to Emmaus. Two disciples walk away from Jerusalem discouraged and confused, unable to recognize that the risen Christ Himself is walking right beside them. Only when Jesus breaks the bread do their eyes open and their hearts burn with renewed faith. In that moment, everything becomes clear: *He is alive, and He is with them.*

This Gospel is not simply a memory from the early Church—it is the pattern of our own encounter with Christ. We, too, can move through our days distracted or burdened, missing the quiet ways the Lord accompanies us. Yet every time we gather for the Eucharist, Jesus once again breaks the bread for us, revealing His presence and renewing our hope. The Emmaus story reminds us that the Eucharist is where the deepening of our faith happens, where hearts are rekindled, and where Christ becomes unmistakably near.

This message speaks beautifully to our parish family as we prepare to celebrate First Holy Communion in just a few weeks. Our children have been learning, praying, and preparing to meet Jesus in the Eucharist for the very first time. Like the disciples on the road, they are about to experience that moment when the Lord reveals Himself in the breaking of the bread. Their excitement and innocence invite all of us to rediscover our own sense of wonder at the Real Presence of Christ.

As we accompany our children toward this sacred day, I encourage families to make the weeks ahead a time of spiritual preparation. Here are some simple, practical ways to help children get ready to receive the Eucharist—not only for the first time, but every week:

- **Talk about Sunday Mass ahead of time** — Share what part of the Mass you love most or what you're looking forward to. Children learn reverence by watching us anticipate the Eucharist with joy.
- **Arrive a few minutes early** — Use that quiet time to pray together, asking Jesus to open your hearts just as He opened the hearts of the disciples on the road to Emmaus.
- **Practice gratitude** — Encourage your child to think of one thing they want to thank Jesus for before receiving Him.
- **Read the Sunday Gospel together** — Even a brief conversation helps children recognize Jesus in the Scriptures before they recognize Him in the Eucharist.
- **Model reverence** — Children absorb what they see. A slow, prayerful genuflection or a moment of silence after Communion teaches more than many words.
- **Talk about the Real Presence in simple terms** — Remind them: "Jesus is really here because He loves you and wants to be close to you."

These small practices help children—and all of us—approach the Eucharist with deeper awareness and love.

Please keep our First Communion children and their families in your prayers. May their hearts burn with joy as they encounter Jesus in the Eucharist, and may their example inspire each of us to approach the altar with renewed gratitude and awe. Let us walk with them, just as Christ walks with us, so that together we may recognize Him more clearly in the Scriptures, in the Eucharist, and in one another.

May the risen Lord continue to open our eyes and set our hearts aflame with His love.

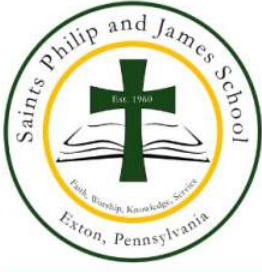
