Dear Parishioners of Divine Savior and our cherished visitors:

Deuteronomy 4:1-2, 6-8; Psalm 15:2-5; James 1:17-18, 21b-22, 27; Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

We return to the Gospel of Mark and will stay with his Gospel on through and including November 14th. In today's Gospel passage, we see at work the dynamic of honor and shame. The Pharisees and scribes, in questioning Jesus about the behavior of His disciples, are attempting to shame Jesus, to dishonor Him by pointing out how unfaithful the disciples are to the tradition as understood by the Pharisees and scribes. The Pharisees would have succeeded in shaming Jesus and nullifying His message had Jesus gotten defensive or tried to make excuses for the disciples' behavior.
