PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners of Divine Savior and our cherished visitors: Isaiah 66:10-14c; Ps. 66:1-7, 16, 20; Gal. 6:14-18; Luke 10:1-9 Transitions can at times be a bit confusing. I write this while I am still pastor but when you all read it, I will no longer be pastor.

The last words of this weekend's Gospel passage state that "the kingdom of God is at hand for you." These words must have seemed strange to the people to whom Luke was writing his Gospel; they certainly don't seem to be describing how we experience life today. But this might just be the point for us. To what degree can we say we have done all we can to make evident that the kingdom of God is at hand. While we realize that we are only a small subset of the universal church, we are invited to reflect on how each of us individually and all of us as a faith community can establish more firmly the characteristics of this kingdom.

These characteristics include all the words we use to describe God, of which the following is a mere sample: love, compassion, mercy, forgiveness, grace, relationship, healing, kindness, generosity, peace and joy. While we can easily come up with reasons that make living out these qualities difficult, we are, nonetheless, called to be our best.

Isaiah in our first reading certainly did not hesitate to state similar invitations to the people of his day. His listeners had recently returned to Jerusalem after an extensive period of exile. The city of Jerusalem and their temple were in ruins. Isaiah presents a refreshing image of God, depicting God in feminine expressions. The people were invited to drink freely of the milk of God's comfort. Isaiah invited them to image God as one whose fondest desire was to touch with great affection all those who were mourning over all the destruction they witnessed. The people were invited to image God as comforting them as a mother comforts her child.

Isaiah invited his people to rejoice; despite all the horrors they were going through, rejoicing comes to be as they and we focus on how God is truly, really present to us. One way to describe God's intimate presence is to imagine God as part of our DNA because of God having created us in love. Jesus, as the Word made flesh, as well as the Holy Spirit are equally an intrinsic and intimate part of our being because they too were present and active in giving us life.

St. Paul in our second reading asks us to collaborate with God in bringing about a new creation. He invites us to be instruments of peace and mercy. We have ample opportunity many times a day to make these gifts of God real for ourselves and for each other as we choose to keep focus on our being God's beloved and precious people. We develop the habit of choosing to embody to the fullest possible degree the qualities listed above as attributes of God. We will slowly but surely be a positive energy in times of all that is contrary to these attributes.

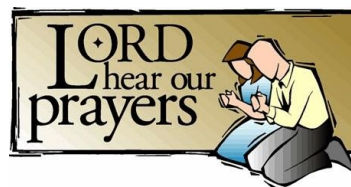
