# Fr. Octavio Trejo-Flores, S.D.S.

John 4: 5-42 | The Woman at the Wall

In our Gospel reading for the Third Sunday of Lent, we heard John's account of "The Woman at the Wall." The Evangelist recounts the story of a Samaritan woman who happened to meet Jesus.

This is how it happened. Jesus and His disciples were on their way towards Galilee. But they had to go through Samaria. It is important to know that in the time of Jesus, Jews and Samaritans had been hostile to one another since the time of King Solomon.

John says that Jesus was resting next to Jacob's well. He also tells us that it was around noon and that Jesus was alone because His disciples went to the town for food. While He was resting, a woman came to draw water from the well. Jesus asked her to give Him some water. Jesus' request surprised the woman for two reasons: 1) the Jesus did not deal with the Samaritans, and 2) they never addressed women in public. Jesus could have waited for the return of His disciples and requested a drink from them.

Then, a conversation between Jesus and the Samaritan woman took place. Note that Jesus was the one who took the initiative to start a conversation with her. You shall know that Jesus broke with the cultural scheme when He did that. You should also ask yourselves why a woman came to draw water from the well alone at noon. John tells us that she was living with a man, but they were not married. Apparently, the Samaritan woman was marginalized by her own people because she was a sinner. Jesus worried about the salvation of this woman, and He offered her a drink of the living water. At that moment, she acknowledged that Jesus was the Christ and she asked Him for a drink of the water of salvation.

Like in today's Gospel, Jesus not only invites us to drink from the water of salvation, but also challenges us to change our lives. The Evangelist John tells us that after the encounter with Jesus, the woman preached to the whole town what Jesus did for her, which indicates that she became a disciple of Jesus. And, at the end of the day, the whole town believed in Jesus as did the woman at the wall.

To conclude, let me ask you a few questions: are you willing to meet Jesus and let Him quench your spiritual thirst? Are you willing to preach the good news of Jesus to those who still do not know Him? Are you willing to allow Jesus to transform your life?

Take time to ponder these questions this week and allow Jesus the opportunity to transform your whole life. When you allow Jesus to enter into your life, you will experience the love of God, and you will never feel that something is missing in your life. Drink from the water of salvation that Jesus offers you! AMEN.
