Matthew 11:25-30 | The Gentle Mastery of Christ

I am sure that many of us have had bad days. And perhaps, just a few of you may have had very, very, very bad days. Fortunately, the impact on our daily life is temporary. However, unexpected life events can affect our long-term health and well-being.

And so, how we react to those events today can predict our health conditions into the future. Some researchers have shown that overreacting, constantly worrying, and living in a state of anxiety can reduce life expectancy.

Maybe you and I are tired because of mental and emotional conflicts that are draining us of our energy. We need to turn our worries, our concerns, our doubts and fears over to God.

Our Gospel for this 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time contains a verse that many of us need to take to heart. Our Divine Savior says, "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest." It is almost as if Jesus had us in mind when He spoke those beautiful words.

And, indeed, He knows our situation. We are tired, stressed out, and our nerves are on edge. Sometimes this is due to work, or due to stressful situations that we face in our life.

But Jesus Christ says to all of us today, "Come to me...and I will give you rest." I truly believe that is encouraging, isn't it? The rest that our Lord Jesus Christ offers us is not the rest of lying around doing nothing. The rest that Jesus Christ gives is the rest of a renewed mind and a refreshed spirit. It is the rest of a new purpose for life.

And so, are you lying awake at night worrying about your future, worrying about your past, wondering whether you are loved or not, accepted, forgiven? Let me give you some Good News. There is One who loves you very much, who will take your burden upon His shoulders if you will trust Him.

Yes, our Divine Savior says to all of us today, "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest...for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves." AMEN.



NEXT weekend, July 15th/16th, coffee and chocolate will be available for sale in the vestibule after Mass.


Fair Trade coffee and chocolate is sold on the third weekend of every month after all the Masses (except the 5pm). We would love to include the 5pm Mass in the selling
