Matthew 13:24-43 | The Parable of the Weeds

In today's Gospel, we heard that Jesus tells The Parable of the Weeds Among the Wheat. The parable unfolds as follows. Jesus tells us of two sowers and two seeds, "a man who sowed good seed in his field," whom Jesus interprets for us as "the son of man." And a second sower who sowed weeds, is portrayed as the enemy of the first sower, whom Jesus interprets for us as "the devil."

As Jesus continues telling the parable, He says that the "son of man" plows his field and sows good seed. Perhaps, you may wonder who the good seed are. "The good seed" are the children of the kingdom. As you may remember, last Sunday's Gospel, Jesus told "The Parable of the Sower." In this parable, the "seed" was interpreted as "the Word" of God. Now, in The Parable of the Weeds Among the Wheat, the seed has already taken root in us.

Yet while the good workers slept from the harshness of sowing the farm fields, the enemy of the first sower came at night and sowed weeds among the wheat. And then, these weeds grew up to become "the children of the evil one."

We also heard that the workers of "the householder came to him" and asked two questions, "did you not sow good seed in your field? Where have the weeds come from?" These are the questions of humanity resounding across the ages! Why is there evil in the world? The fact that the devil sowed his weed while the workers slept is a sign of the devil's wickedness. It is an indication of his evil ploy to deceive and destroy humanity.

But Jesus is giving us good news today, God is sowing good seeds in His kingdom right now among us. There are a lot of good, beautiful things happening in life that God has given us. But with all the weeds growing around us, it is often hard to see the good things.

I know that our world seems to be out of control. And my friends, please do not give up, the good things in life, sometimes, are hidden. We have the promise of



our heavenly Father in today's Gospel, and if we really trust God, these miracles will happen. Amen
