### Fr. Octavio Trejo-Flores, S.D.S.

Matthew 13:44-52 | The Hidden Treasure and the Pearl

We read in our Gospel reading for this 17<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time the parables of the Hidden Treasure and the Pearl. Jesus teaches us that the Kingdom of Heaven is like a treasure or a valuable pearl and once we found it, it is all we want and worth all we have.

Both of these parables make a similar point about the Kingdom of Heaven. They emphasized how the finders responded to what they found. They know the great value of their find. And so, they also know that what they found is worth more than all we possess. In both parables, the order is the same: joy over finding their find. And then, the willingness to sell all their possessions.

Now, how can we apply today's Gospel to our lives? Our friendship with God is a treasure of love that has no price or comparison—it is the Kingdom of Heaven. Those who have found it know its value and are filled with joy when they find it. Their sacrifice was not out of obligation or done unwillingly, but one done out of joy!

Finally, what does our Gospel teach and what are its challenges? Once we found the joy of the Gospel, our joy in it produces a willingness to give all we have to God: our talents, time, and resources.

It should also affect the way we live and respond to life's challenges. Our joy should make it easier for us to obey Jesus's commandments. This joy of finding the Kingdom of Heaven results in radical life change, the kind of change that makes other people wonder and ask questions. Amen.

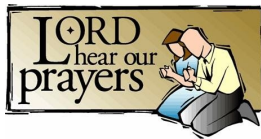


### CONFESSION

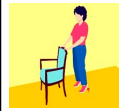
