Matthew 15:21-28 | The Canaanite Woman's Faith

As we heard in today's Gospel, it appears that Jesus does not come off looking very good in His treatment of the Canaanite woman. My friends, if all we had was this passage, we would think that Jesus was bad-mannered.

So, let us walk through our Gospel reading for this 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time. First, we read that Jesus seemed to ignore the woman. Then He told her she is not the right kind of people. And finally, He referred to her as a canine. That does not sound like the Jesus we all know and love, does it not? So, what is going on?

If most of us had been met like this woman was met by Jesus, perhaps, we would have been out of there very quickly. But she just kept on coming, kept on pleading with Jesus to heal her daughter. And as we read, she got on her knees and begged. Even Jesus' disciples came and asked Him, "Send her away." And Jesus said in reply, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." Indeed, Scripture did say that the people of Israel were God's chosen nation.

However, and as we read in the Gospel, Jesus was not putting this woman down. He not only used the Canaanite woman's situation to open the eyes of the disciples, but also to open our eyes as well. My friends, our Divine Savior is teaching us that many of our broken relationships and most of our sense of alienation from one another comes from our own attitudes and prejudice. That is, our own attitudes and prejudice can be used to build fences that divide us.

But Jesus came to break down those fences that divide us from each other and from God. When we accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior of our lives, the things that separate us disappear. There is only one thing that is important, we are in need of a Savior. Amen.

MINISTRY TO THE HOMEBOUND




We take communion to people in eight local facilities, several smaller Board & Cares and to those homebound and unable to attend Mass for an extended period.
