Matthew 18:15-20 | Peace and Reconciliation

Our liturgy of the Word for this 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time is fundamental for the reconciliation practices in our Church. They clearly assert for us the need to love God and love our neighbor and how to express it through responsibility for the peace and reconciliation in our community. And so, we, the Church, take responsibility for the spiritual health of her members.

Jesus points out that first step to reconciliation is to raise the issue and the concern and allow an opportunity for change: "If your brother/sister sins... go and tell him/her." That is, we should take up the responsibility for reconciliation, seek good knowledge, use communal discernment, work towards consensus in the body of Christ about the situation, and in all things, we should be seeking the conversion of the one doing wrong by Indeed, Jesus emphasizes the power of communal prayer, and He assures us His presence among the gathered community.

We, the Church, strive to understand the qualities of God's mercy. In that extent, we have to do our best to bring people who make mistakes closer to the fold so that they can be reconciled with God, so they may experience God's love.

Sadly, there are some voices or behaviors in our Church that may not sound much like God's mercy. Thus, the questions here are: how do we take this up today? And so, do you strive to be a bridge between God's love and those outside the fold? Or a stumbling block for those who need God's mercy? Amen.


