Matthew 21:33-46 | The Parable of the Tenants

Have you ever been rejected? It is painful, isn't it? As far as the brain is concerned, a broken heart may not be so different from a broken arm. To many of us, there is no pain more familiar than the pain of rejection.

Indeed, rejection might impact our feelings, our thoughts and even our health. Yes, rejection is painful! Whether you are being rejected by the opposite sex or being rejected by your peers. Rejection is painful!


The parable from today's Gospel deals with that very thing, 'rejection.' As we heard in the Gospel, Jesus was speaking to the chief priests and the elders of the people, and He told them 'The Parable of the Tenants.' After He finished telling the story, He said to them, "The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone." What an important statement: Jesus, the stone that was rejected has become the cornerstone. Jesus, who was rejected, now is seated at the right hand of God the Father.

However, if Jesus did not confront life's most heartbreaking difficulties and disappointments, how could He help us to deal with rejection?

And so, I have very good news for you today. Our Divine Savior can help us when we feel rejected. Jesus was rejected that we might be reconciled to God. And now, He has become the cornerstone. Because Jesus knows what it is to be rejected, He can help us with our feelings of rejection. Isn't that a miracle?

But you may be wondering how we can deal with feelings of rejection. First of all, when we are rejected, we should not give up. Instead, we have to allow Jesus Christ to use that rejection to help us grow in maturity and to help us better minister to others who also feel rejected.

In our second reading St. Paul advises us, "Have no anxiety at all." We really need to trust God in every circumstance, challenge, or situation we may struggle with. Just remember that our Divine Savior, "The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone." Amen.


