Matthew 22: 1-14 | The Parable of the Wedding Feast

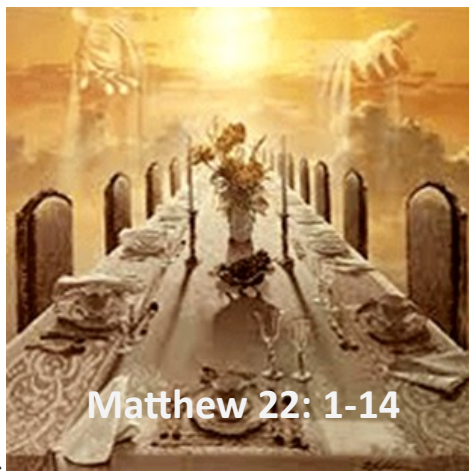
In today's Gospel, we read the Parable of the Wedding Feast. In Jesus' story there are two groups of guests. In the first group we find all those on the list of special guests. And in the second group we find all those who heard about the wedding celebration.

Let us begin with the first group of guests. We know that they were the first ones who received the King's invitation. But they rejected his invitation by making excuses. Also, they did more than reject the invitation. They killed the messengers that brought them their invitations. Their refusal to join in the celebration was clearly shown by their actions.

Now let us move to the next group of guests. The King extended his invitation to all, "bad and good alike." But with the invitation there comes expectation. And Jesus was clear about this point. The expectation was that each guest would acknowledge their entry into this "wedding feast" by making some changes in themselves. In the parable the "change" required is in clothing. In the life of faith, the "change" required is not a change of clothes, but a change of life.

Jesus portrays God as the King who is inviting us to the wedding feast of His Son. We are all invited, whether the world judges us to be good or bad, worthy or unworthy. The invitation is without restrictions. But that does not mean that the invitation is without expectations. We are all granted full admission to the Kingdom of Heaven through the gracious "free pass" offered by Jesus Christ. But there are requirements. We cannot remain unchanged. We cannot remain indifferent or critical towards others.

And this is a requirement by the One who has invited us to the wedding feast of His Son. A seat in the Kingdom of Heaven takes a commitment to changing something. That is, we have been invited to do nothing less than change the world through the power of the Divine Savior. Amen.

Formation Opportunity

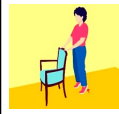
