Matthew 23:1-12

Denunciation of the Scribes and Pharisees

From Jesus' description of the scribes and Pharisees in today's Gospel, we can just about guess how those religious leaders were, but also, how they would have identified themselves. They probably would have described themselves by saying, "I am a rabbi, or I am a teacher." Of course, each of these titles demanded a great deal of respect. That is, they were seen as holy people.

Now, if we compare the descriptions of the religious leaders of Jesus' time to the ways in which we identify ourselves, some similarities become clear. We would describe ourselves as: teacher, attorney, doctor, priest, and so on. We tend to identify ourselves by what we do.

Some people have a longing to be regarded with respect, and that is good. Indeed, God has given us unique gifts and talents to use in the service of others. But sometimes, people's desire for respect leads to a competitive drive to be seen as superior to others. Then, it is not sufficient to be a productive and faithful worker.

However, as children of God, we are freed from judging others. Our only responsibility is to let people know, out there, that our Divine Savior has come to us to save us all. And we really have to believe that statement. We have to believe in Him with all our heart that He is our Lord and Savior. Jesus frees us from the responsibility of judging the behavior of others, so that all we need to do is humbly serve Him. Amen.
