John 1: 6-8, 19-28 | Gaudete Sunday

This Third Sunday of Advent is known as *Gaudete* Sunday—the Sunday of Joy. And you may be wondering why. In a few more days, we will be celebrating Jesus' birth. And so, "Rejoice in the Lord always, again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near!" (Cf. Phil. 4:4-5).

On this Sunday, the theme of *Gaudete*, the sound of rejoicing, still flows forth. And today's Gospel clearly tells us that it is time to rejoice, our period of preparation and waiting is approaching its end. The Lord is near! The promise of God certainly reached its peak in the promise of the Christ, the Messiah. God always provides the means to find the light.

The scene was set for the appearance of John the Baptist in the desert. Like the great prophets of earlier generations, John was sent to bring the light of God to a people in darkness. And the darkness of the people of Israel in John's time was the oppression of the Roman empire.

The third Sunday of Advent is traditionally a time to rejoice for the long journey, our patient waiting is coming to an end. A new day will soon begin. Indeed, St. Paul echoes this powerful theme: "Rejoice always."

We must rejoice as St. Paul advises because the Lord is near! There is a light at the end of the tunnel. And all of us must pass through the darkness in the journey of life to reach the light. As we experience our challenges, we must constantly seek the light, but we know that the light is only found at the end of a tunnel. We must never fear to go forward, and we have to embrace the challenges that come our way. We learn the most and greatest lessons in life from engaging in problematic situations. It is true that sometimes we will fail, but other times we will be successful. But each time, we will learn some important lessons of life. For example, our Lord Jesus embraced His cross without regard to its humiliation. Surely, there is no need for us to look for obstacles and problems because they will certainly come our way. But we should not run away when they find us.

In order to successfully go across this darkness, we have to continually seek the light. Advent is a time when we take a journey from the darkness, which is the absence of God to the birth of the light, which is Jesus. Today's Gospel tells us it is time to rejoice for the light, the Lord is near!

And so, we can have total confidence that whatever covers us in darkness, whether it be loneliness, sickness, losing a job, or problems with faith, it can be dissipated by the coming of the light—our Lord Jesus Christ. As we continue our Advent journey, let us get rid of darkness and seek the light. My friends, it is time to rejoice. The Lord is near! Amen.
