# Pastor's Corner

## *The Body Glorified in the Kingdom*

As we conclude our liturgical year today with the Solemnity of Jesus Christ the King of the Universe, we also give thanks for all that our God has done for humanity. The manner of which our God has fashioned us in His image and likeness and set us apart to participate in a mission that is other worldly. As we have prayed for and focused on our earthly passing and those who have gone before us, we believe that God created the human person as a union of body and soul, and, had Adam never sinned, that unity would have remained intact. The separation that occurs at death is a consequence of original sin.

Today we hear some of the last words of Jesus dying on the cross, offering his mercy to the repentant thief. Soon thereafter, Jesus will die and rise again, and by doing so, opened up the path to reunification. Just as his body and soul were joined once more when he rose from the dead, transformed, and was glorified, so too will all the bodies and souls of all the just be reunited when we are resurrected, transformed, and glorified. The body that the soul rejoins will be your body – the same body reading these words right now – but it will also be different.

How this is possible and all of the other questions, such as what body will it be, are questions with few answers. According to the Catechism, when it comes to the resurrection of the bodies, we know five things: 1) "God ... will definitely grant incorruptible life to our bodies by reuniting them with our souls, through the power of Jesus' resurrection"; 2) "All the dead will rise"; 3) "All of them will rise again with their own bodies which they now bear"; 4) Our resurrection is connected with the Eucharist; and 5) This resurrection will happen on "the last day" (CCC 1000).

That's it. That's all we can definitely say about what lies behind the veil of death. Everything else "exceeds our imagination and understanding; it is accessible only to faith" (CCC 1000).

And why and how can this be? Because Jesus Christ is King of Heaven and earth!! Let's rejoice in God's goodness, that we can participate in the Kingdom through our good works, kind words and seeking to be better disciples. Look at the many ways you might assist others during this beautiful season of Advent that approaches and devote your household to increased prayer. All of these actions and attitudes keep us joined for eternity to the Body of Christ.







## Virtus

The Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas is committed to creating safe environments. In addition to attending a Virtus Protecting God's Children for Adults Awareness session, all employees and all volunteers working around youth or vulnerable adults must submit to a background check and read and sign our (3) Archdiocesan policies regarding abuse prevention, ethics and harassment.

To maintain safe environments in our schools and parishes, the Archdiocese has ongoing requirements for our clergy, employees and volunteers to remain in compliance. All Catholic School employees are required to complete background screenings and acknowledge policy every 3 years and likewise every 5 years for all clergy, volunteers and parish staff. The Office for Protection & Care oversees all the prevention efforts throughout the archdiocese. As many of you know, our office partners with VIRTUS to implement many of the requirements. If you are a current employee or volunteer around youth or vulnerable you will be notified through the VIRTUS platform automatically via email 30 days in advance of when your background check comes up for renewal. Please make sure you log into your existing VIRTUS account to complete the process within 30 days of notification. If you receive the notice and are no longer volunteering, please contact your local parish/school Safe Environment Coordinator ("SEC") at (XXX name and phone number). We rely heavily on our local SEC's to ensure these requirements are met--please join us in sharing our gratitude for their tireless efforts!

We are a community committed to preventing abuse. Our policies and programs prioritize safety of children and the vulnerable. We can all make an important difference by being a part of the safety net for our youth and vulnerable population. Thank you for doing your part.


