# Pastor's Corner

## New Year's Feasts

This article is positioned uniquely on the church and secular calendars. Today is the Feast of the Holy Family, the 4th day of the Christmas season, and in 4 days we celebrate New Year's Day and the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God and the World Day of Peace, as declared by Pope St. Paul VI in 1968.

One of the many beautiful aspects of our Faith is that all the doctrines and teachings are interconnected, ultimately finding their foundation in one or more persons of the Trinity. None are isolated, including the significance of each of these celebrations.

Beginning with today's celebration of the feast of the Holy Family, the Church directs our attention to the fact that, like each of us, Jesus was born into a family as an infant. This reality emphasizes His humility. For God to take on human flesh is a humbling enough event, but He did so in the most vulnerable ways. He relied on His mother and father for all His necessities and safety. The great and almighty God began His time on Earth utterly dependent on others. Along the same line, while He was God, His human nature had to learn as humans do. He had to learn to walk, to talk, and to work. He also had to learn His Jewish faith, beginning in what we refer to today as the "domestic church." It was with Mary and Joseph that Jesus learned to read scripture and pray. They would ensure He went to the temple to worship and listen to the rabbis explain the faith. In His home, with His parents, He would celebrate feasts like Passover and learn about sacrificing for atonement. So, on this feast of the Holy Family, our own families are illuminated as domestic churches where we practice our faith with those closest to us, while looking to the Holy Family as an example of how Jesus entered so fully into our human experience.

The Holy Family shows us, by their example, that the law established by God is good and worthy of being followed. We learn the virtue of obedience to the law by knowing that even Jesus and His family were obedient to it.

Next, we have the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God. As Catholics, we honor Mary for she is rightfully called the Mother of God because she bore Jesus, who is true God and true man. Jesus, the Son of God, received His human flesh from His human mother. I cannot think of a more important person in human history, second to Jesus, than Mary. To honor her on this feast is to offer thanksgiving for the greatest gift anyone could have ever given us. It is also fitting for us to honor her because Mary raised the child, Jesus, provided for all of His basic needs, and taught Him the faith at home. Mary, the Mother of God, raised Jesus during the hidden years to emerge as the man entering public ministry. She provided love, tenderness, and support during His entire life, to the bitter end at the foot of His cross, all for our sake. By honoring Mary, we proclaim the truth of who Jesus is.

January 1 was also dedicated as World Day of Peace by Pope St. Paul VI. In his first address on this day in 1968, he stated that observing a day of peace ought not change the liturgical calendar, rather the liturgical calendar should shed light on our yearning for peace and from where it comes. Jesus is the Prince of Peace, brought forth from Mary's womb, and the source of all peace. The family then is a good place to practice peace. It is where we first experience irritation, frustration, and even hurt, enabling us to practice patience, perseverance, and most importantly, forgiveness. In the family, wounds and tensions are brought to the surface where they can have an opportunity to heal through bonds of love strengthened by Jesus' wounds of love. Having several crucifixes in our homes could strengthen us in daily life and family struggles.

Finally, we celebrate New Year's Day, when we tend to look at the past year and use it as a guide to set goals for ourselves in the coming year. In the context of these liturgical feast days, we ought to closely examine our faith and our growth in holiness and virtue. No one is guaranteed tomorrow, so it is important to live our faith daily. As the new year begins, think about your family and domestic church. It is certainly not perfect and has its wounds, but what is God teaching you in the imperfections? How does the gift that Mary gave you, her Son, Jesus, help you understand your domestic church more deeply? How does Jesus' obedience to the law and the shedding of His blood encourage you to be more obedient to God's will and to sacrifice yourself for the good of others? And how does all of this shed new light on the meaningful peace this world desperately craves?

## 2025: Ways to Give to Nativity

As year-end approaches, we would like to remind you of various ways you can contribute to the parish, which may also benefit you for tax purposes. According to IRS guidelines, **contributions must be received no later than December 31, 2025** to be included on your 2025 tax statement from the church.

### Appreciated Stock

A transfer of appreciated stock whether publicly traded, mutual fund, ETF or privately-held, all which need to have been owned for longer than one year, is an efficient way to contribute. You may receive a tax deduction based on the value of the stock on the date transfer and avoid paying tax on the appreciation from your cost basis. Please contact the business office for stock transfer instructions for Nativity's brokerage account.

### Qualified Charitable Contribution from your IRA

Do you own an IRA? Are you 70 ½ or older? Maximize your giving impact and tax benefits! Support Nativity through an IRA qualified charitable distribution (QCD) gift. The distribution must come directly from your IRA to Nativity. Consult your financial advisor or broker to set up a distribution.

- **Tax-free giving:** directly from your IRA to your favorite church ministries (up to \$105,000/yr)
- **Count towards RMD:** satisfy your required minimum distribution for the year (generally, for those 73+)
- **Planned giving:** conducive to annual giving all-at-once or strategically throughout the year

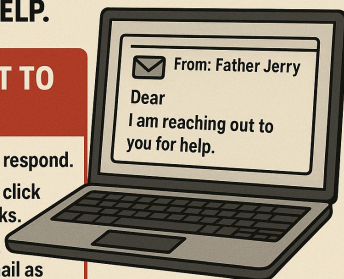

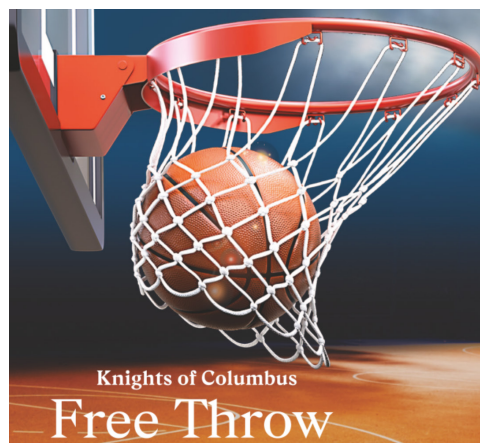

## Virtus

The Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas is committed to creating safe environments. In addition to attending a Virtus Protecting God's Children for Adults Awareness session, all employees and all volunteers working around youth or vulnerable adults must submit to a background check and read and sign our (3) Archdiocesan policies regarding abuse prevention, ethics and harassment.

To maintain safe environments in our schools and parishes, the Archdiocese has ongoing requirements for our clergy, employees and volunteers to remain in compliance. All Catholic School employees are required to complete background screenings and acknowledge policy every 3 years and likewise every 5 years for all clergy, volunteers and parish staff. The Office for Protection & Care oversees all the prevention efforts throughout the archdiocese. As many of you know, our office partners with VIRTUS to implement many of the requirements. If you are a current employee or volunteer around youth or vulnerable you will be notified through the VIRTUS platform automatically **via email** 30 days in advance **of** when your background check comes up for renewal. Please make sure you log into your existing VIRTUS account to complete the process within 30 days of notification. If you receive the notice and are no longer volunteering, please contact your local parish/school Safe Environment Coordinator ("SEC") at (XXX name and phone number). We rely heavily on our local SEC's to ensure these requirements are met--please join us in sharing our gratitude for their tireless efforts!

We are a community committed to preventing abuse. Our policies and programs prioritize safety of children and the vulnerable. We can all make an important difference by being a part of the safety net for our youth and vulnerable population. Thank you for doing your part.
