- Start your meeting with a prayer together.

Twenty Questions to Ask your Confirmation Sponsor

- **1.** At what age did you get confirmed?
- **2.** What do you remember about getting confirmed?
- 3. What saint name did you take as your confirmation name?
- 4. What did you like about confirmation and what did you not understand?
- **5.** How has the Holy Spirit played a role in your life?
- **6.** Since getting confirmed, what has been your most influential faith moment?
- 7. When did you get baptized? Were you a baby? Did you go through RCIA?
- 8. How did you first learn about what it means to be Catholic?
- **9.** What does it mean to you to be Catholic?
- **10.** How has the Catholic faith strengthened and nourished you?
- **11.** How has your appreciation of the Mass changed for you over your life? Was there a time when you did not like going to Mass? Do you like going to Mass now? Why?
- **12.** What does "forgiveness" mean to you? How does this understanding of forgiveness help you with the Sacrament of Reconciliation?
- **13.** What has been your experience of the Sacrament of Reconciliation? Has it been a rewarding experience for you?
- **14.** Do you have a favorite place and time to pray? Describe a time when it was challenging to pray and a time when you really felt God's presence.
- **15.** In what ways have being Christian shaped your life?
- **16.** Describe a time when you felt really close to God.
- **17.** Who has been a good role model for you? How has this person taught you or shown you what it means to be Catholic? How has this person deepened your faith?
- 18. In what areas would you like to see growth in your Catholic faith?
- **19.** What is your favorite Scripture passage, verse or story? Why?
- **20.** What is the greatest challenge of being Catholic? What is the best thing about being Catholic?
