REFLECTION

As we gather to celebrate the Eucharist, let us not forget that the word "Eucharist" means "thanksgiving". The Greek word *eukharistia* is used to describe what Jesus did before sharing his body and blood at the Last Supper. Today, as always, we give thanks to God for all the blessings we have received and continue to receive, especially for Jesus Christ, God's only Son, whom we receive in a special way today in the Eucharist.

In our Liturgy today, Naaman, a foreigner, returns to Elisha and promises to worship God exclusively after he is cured of his leprosy. Another foreigner, a Samaritan, is the only one of ten lepers who returns to thank Jesus after being cured. Physically and socially, their lives have been completely transformed and their immediate response is to return and give thanks. As we listen to today's readings, let us consider how God has blessed us. Thanks be to God!
