REFLECTION

Jesus challenges us to turn the other cheek and to love our enemies. These are not our instincts. It is not easy. We get angry, we are upset, we want to do or say something to express that pain and rage. As we approach the season of Lent, let the example of our Lord inspire us to respond to hurt and conflict with mercy and forgiveness.

In the first line of the first reading we hear God tell Moses, "Be holy, for I, the LORD, your God, am holy." Then in the last line of the Gospel Jesus tells his disciples, "Be perfect, just as your heavenly Father is perfect." How's that for a challenge? Not only are we told to be holy, we are told to be perfect! The truth is that we can be neither without God's help. Listening to today's readings, not how Father, Son, and Holy Spirit can perfect in us their earthly dwelling.

Lenten Fast and Abstinence Regulations:

FASTING: On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, those who are 18 but not yet 60 are allowed only one full meal. Two smaller meals are allowed as needed, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

<u>ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT:</u> Those who are 14 years of age or older are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

The Church no longer attempts to prescribe Lenten practices in detail. The above regulations simply highlight Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the other Fridays of Lent. The more fundamental obligation is to make Lent a penitential season, choosing practices that are adapted to one's own circumstances.

Corporal Works of Mercy

These are acts of charity designated by Jesus. Unlike the beatitudes which were clearly delineated by Jesus on the mountain, the corporal works of mercy are also from Jesus, but are a compilation of his teachings, particularly from Matthew 25:35-36. The seven corporal works of mercy are:

- 1. To feed the hungry.
- 2. To give drink to the thirsty.
- 3. To clothe the naked.
- 4. To shelter the homeless.
- 5. To visit the sick.
- 6. To visit the imprisoned.
- 7. To bury the dead.

In recent years, some lists have been changed to combine visiting the sick and prisoners, and then adding "give alms to the poor" as the seventh work of mercy. The Prophet Isaiah said: "Share your bread with the hungry, shelter the oppressed and the homeless; clothe the naked when you see them, and do not turn your back on your own." – Isaiah 58:7


