Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord

REFLECTION

Alleluia! Sing out with joy for the Easter miracle. The Lord is risen. We have been redeemed. Death no longer has ultimate power over us. We anticipate the day when we too will be raised with Christ. As baptized Christians, we have already been raised. We have been raised out of the ashes of despair, raised up to the luminosity of salvation. "This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad."

Every Easter Sunday we hear from three saints who bear witness to Christ's resurrection: Peter, Paul, and John. Peter testifies to Jesus' life and mission, Paul to the effect that his rising has on us, and John gives an account of what happened on that first Easter morn. Listening to today's scripture passages, let us reflect on how we can witness to Jesus' rising from the dead.

John 20:1-9: Three witnesses, Mary, Peter, and John respond to the empty tomb.

THE ALPHA AND OMEGA

Alpha and Omega These letters are the first
and last letters of the
Greek alphabet. They
symbolize that God is
the beginning of all
things and will be, at the
end of all things.



THE CROSS

The cross reminds us that Christ is the center of our lives.



WE PRAY

Christ,
yesterday and today,
The beginning and the end...
May Christ the light
guard us
and protect us.

Amen.



CURRENT YEAR 2020

Reminds us that Christ is with us now, but also, that He has been, and will be, throughout time with those who gather around the Paschal candle.



INCENSE NAILS

Five grains of incense (wrapped in wax), shaped like "nails"remind us of both the five wounds of Christ and the anointing of His body before being placed in the tomb.
