ANNUAL MEMORIAL DAY MASS: The Memorial Day Mass at the St. Mary's Queen of Peace Cemetery will be held on Monday, May 29, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. We are pleased to announce that Rev. David W. Beaubien, pastor at St. Aloysius Church in Leonardtown, will be our main celebrant. Mass is offered each year at this time for the deceased members of the parishes of St. Mary's, Charles, Calvert, and Prince George's Counties and especially for those who have passed away during the past year. Commemorative reading of the faithful departed will begin at 9:15 a.m. The cemetery is in Helen, MD on Doctor Johnson Road adjacent to the Mother Catherine Academy (Route 238). An enclosable tent will be erected for everyone's comfort so the Mass will be held in the cemetery rain or shine. Our Lady's Chapel Cemetery Society P.O. Box 1226 Leonardtown, MD 20650 Catholic Cemeteries of the Archdiocese of Washington (CCAW) is kindly requesting your attention to help maintain the beauty and dignity of our sacred grounds by following these regulations:

- 1. Fresh cut flowers are welcome all year.
- 2. Artificial flowers are permitted only from November 15 until March 15.
- 3. Flowers of any type may be removed by the cemetery groundskeeper or a Catholic Cemeteries representative when they become unsightly or the particular season/holiday is over.
- 4. Other decorations such as glass containers, candles, lights, metal staffs, benches, rocks, bricks, stones, landscaping edging of any kind, or chairs, etc are prohibited and subject to removal.
- 5. Individual planting of trees, shrubs, flowers, etc is not allowed.
- 6. Pets are not permitted on cemetery grounds.

Each Parish is responsible for mowing and trimming the cemetery as well as enforcing these regulations. CCAW assists in resetting and straightening memorials as requested by the Pastor or family.


CHARITABLE OUTREACH COMMITTEE
