TODAY'S READINGS

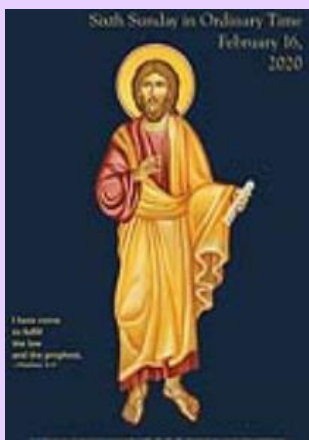
First Reading — God allows us to make choices, but we are not to choose injustice or sinfulness

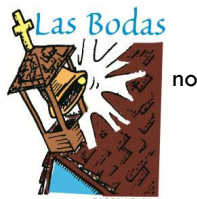
Nuestra Misión Parroquial
