FROM THE DESK OF FATHER MAC

After more than three months, we have begun to reopen our parish. With thanks to Almighty God, we celebrated our first public Masses since mid-March last week. It was a momentous undertaking to prepare our church for reopening and I am deeply grateful to all of our parish ministers and volunteers who have assisted us in the process of reopening our doors and have helped us to welcome people back to Mass. It's important to remember that the process of reopening our parish is a step-by-step process. We need to be patient and prudent, always erring on the side of caution.

As we continue to cope with the COVID-19 pandemic and as we continue to confront the pervasive presence of racism and discrimination in our country, it is truly a blessing to be able to gather once again for Mass and receive the Eucharist so that we can receive the spiritual strength and nourishment we need to endure these challenging times.

To those of you have returned to Mass, I thank you for your patience in bearing with all of the adjustments to the normal way we celebrate Mass and for your cooperation in observing the health and safety protocols we have implemented to make the experience of Mass as safe as possible. We can't totally eliminate risk but we can mitigate risk and the stringent health & safety protocols we have implemented are designed to do just that. For those of you who have not yet returned to church but are planning to attend Mass in the coming weeks, I invite you to visit our parish website at www.st-cyril.org to read all of our reopening guidelines so you know what to expect when you come to church.

I am deeply conscious of the fact that many members of our parish are not returning to church at this time. We continue to encourage people in vulnerable populations, i.e. persons 65 years and older, and those with underlying health conditions, to stay safe and stay home at this time. There are also some who do not yet feel comfortable returning to church. You are not required to attend. Archbishop Gomez has extended to dispensation from the Sunday Mass obligation until further notice. You are encouraged to participate in Mass on TV or the internet. We will continue livestreaming the Sunday 10AM Mass from St. Cyril's.

While it pains me that many members of our community are physically separated from us as they continue to shelter at home, it's important to remember that we while we may not be physically together, we are still united spiritually, and no matter where we find ourselves, together we form the community of Saint Cyril's! Our church transcends the four walls of our church building. Whether attending Mass or not during this time, each of us is a living stone that together forms Saint Cyril of Jerusalem Parish!

The National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism reports that nearly 5,000 children under the age of 21 die from alcohol-related incidents every year. 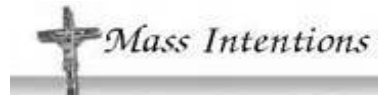

Important Health and Safety Protocols as we return to church

Your safety is our top concern! To keep everyone safe and to comply with the COVID-19 directives of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles and public health authorities, the following procedures and policies will be in effect at St. Cyril's until further notice:

- **If you exhibit a fever, cough, or shortness of breath you are asked not to enter the church or be on parish grounds.** You should stay home in safety or seek medical assistance if needed.
- **You must wear a face mask covering your mouth and nose at all times on parish grounds and in the church.** This does not apply to children 2 years or younger. Adults who are unable to wear a face mask should not come to church.
- **Hands must be washed or sanitized before entering the church.**
- **Please use only designated doors to enter or exit the church.**
- **No more than 100 persons may be admitted in church at one time.** Reservations are required to attend Sunday Mass until further notice.
- **Social distance of at least 6 ft. from others must be maintained at all times** except between those of the same household. Please observe floor markings to help maintain distance.
- **Once you are seated, stay in your pew** and do not move around the church or congregate with others. Please follow usher's instructions for Communion and for exiting the church.
- **Holy Water, Hymnals & Misallettes are removed.** Consider bringing your own Missal.
- **There will be no collection.** Place your donation in the baskets as you come to Communion.
- **There will be no Sign of Peace. Do not shake hands or make physical contact with others.**
- **Communion will be distributed in the hand only. No cup.**
- **Those 65 years or older or those with underlying medical conditions should NOT come to Mass.** Archbishop Gomez has dispensed the faithful from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. You may view the livestream of our Sunday 10:00AM Mass on our YouTube channel.

The pandemic has been difficult for us all, but we are confident that with your prayers, and through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Health of the Sick, we will one day soon be able to come together again as a community to celebrate our Catholic faith fully in the many ways to which we are accustomed. Until that day comes, we thank you for your understanding and cooperation in following these guidelines, and we ask God's blessings so that we may all stay safe & healthy.
