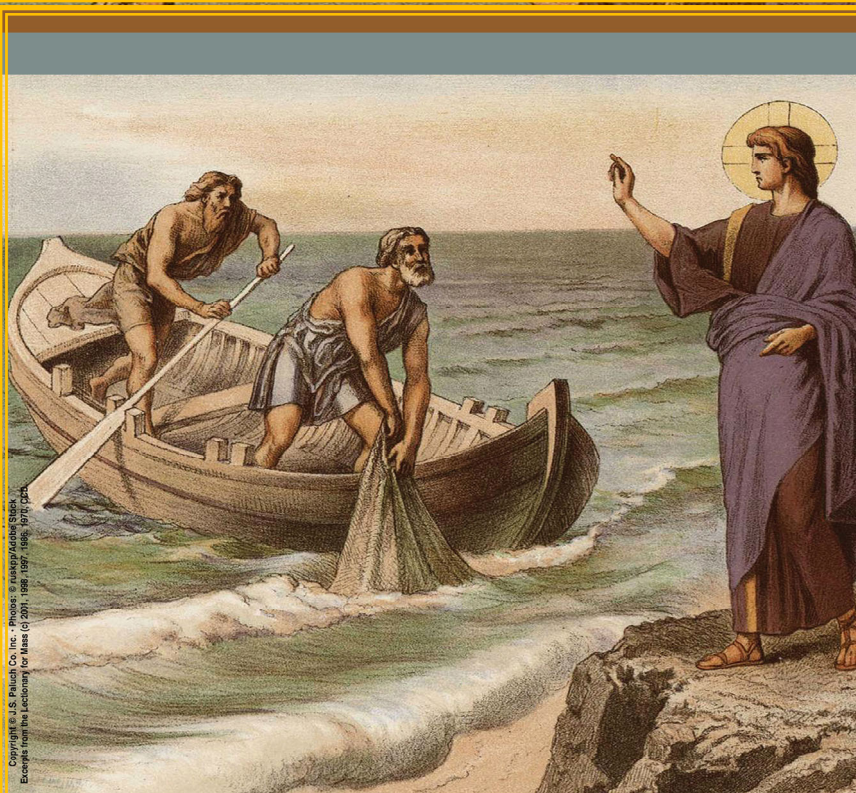

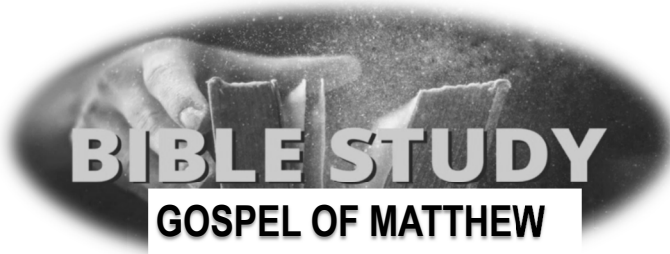

“Sunday of the Word of God” - Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

On September 30, 2019, on the liturgical memorial of St. Jerome, Pope Francis announced that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time would be celebrated as the *Sunday of the Word of God*.

“May the Sunday of the Word of God help his people to grow in religious and intimate familiarity with the sacred Scriptures.”

This is Pope Francis’ hope on the day he instituted in his Apostolic Letter, in the form of a Motu Proprio of the Holy Father Francis, “*Aperuit illis*”, instituting the Sunday of the Word of God.

Stressing how essential it is for Catholics to familiarize themselves with Christ’s written word, Pope Francis highlights “*a day devoted to the Bible should not be seen as a yearly event but rather a year-long event.*”

“Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, as in all wisdom you teach and admonish one another, singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God”
(Colossians 3:16)

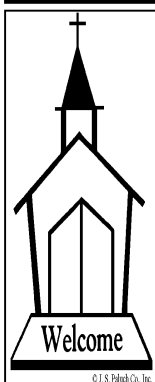

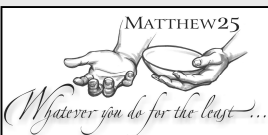

Learn how to help children suffering from trauma

With mass shootings, natural disasters, and the social climate today, our children are living in a world that can be very scary at times. Children who have

suffered from trauma, through abuse, loss, or another tragedy, may have different ways of viewing the world through the distorted lens of their fears and worries, and often need the help of trusted adults to guide them through their emotions. Many children use denial as their first coping method, so getting them to talk about what's happened and explore how they're feeling and what scares them now is important. Consider consulting someone with expertise in child development – a psychologist, counselor or experienced teacher might have suggestions as to how best to support a child in the aftermath of a frightening experience. 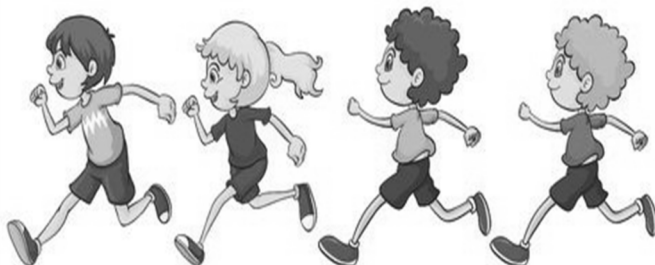


We're bringing the Jog-a-thon back!
