Respect Life Month 2021 | Reflection St. Joseph: Faithful Protector of Mother and Child

The infant Christ “came into our world in a state of great vulnerability. He needed to be defended, protected, cared for and raised by Joseph” (PC 5). The humble and often hidden carpenter of Nazareth accompanied Mary in her pregnancy, assisted at the birth of the Messiah in a stable, presented Jesus in the Temple, fled with his family far from their homeland to protect them, and lovingly raised Jesus as his own son in the years to come.

While the angel of the Lord appeared to Mary to announce that she would bring forth the Savior of the world, it was revealed to Joseph in a series of dreams how God's plans would be brought to fulfillment. As Pope Francis highlights, “God trusted Joseph, as did Mary, who found in him someone who would not only save her life, but would always provide for her and her child” (PC 5).

Like every other human family, the Holy Family had to confront real and concrete challenges. Yet, “in every situation, Joseph declared his own ‘fiat’” (PC 3). His “yes” to the Lord meant that regardless of the hardship and personal sacrifice to himself, he consistently chose to put the needs of Mary and Jesus before his own. Joseph's devotion helps reveal to us our own call to show special care for the lives of those whom God has entrusted to us.

During this Year of St. Joseph, each of us can find in him “an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble” (PC, Intro). Joseph shows us how to say “yes” to life, despite our own fears, frailties, and weaknesses. For it is Joseph who was “chosen by God to guide the beginnings of the history of redemption. He was the true ‘miracle’ by which God saves the child and his mother” (PC 5).

May we, too, be miracles in the lives of those who are most in need, especially at the beginning and end of life. Dear St. Joseph, you who were “able to turn a problem into a possibility by trusting always in divine providence” (PC 5), help us to imitate your faithful trust and courage.

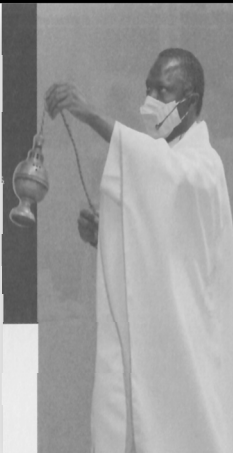

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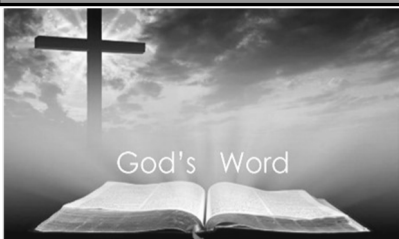

Did you know?

Talking about stranger danger

The idea of "stranger danger" is often too broad a concept for children to grasp as not all strangers are dangerous, and children will always be meeting new people and on occasion may need to ask a stranger for help. Instead of issuing a blanket warning, try these tips for keeping children safe around people they do not know. If an unknown adult approaches them, have

them check with a parent or known and trusted adult before engaging in conversation. This can be as simple as a quick look to the parent followed by a nod indicating that it is okay to interact. As an adult yourself, you can set a good example by talking first to parents, then to children in their care. This helps your own children see how trustworthy adults engage with children around their parents and helps them learn caution for adults who do not act in the same way.

What is the Rosary?

Rosary comes from the Latin word "Rosarium" which means "CROWN OF ROSES." Praying the Hail Mary is like giving a rose to Mary. Praying the whole Rosary is like giving her a "crown of roses."

When do we celebrate the Month of the Holy Rosary?

In October 1, 1571, the Christians won the battle of Lepanto where they prayed and asked for Mary's intercession through the Holy Rosary. Because of this, in 1883, Pope Leo XIII dedicated the month of October to the Holy Rosary.



Did you know?

- The term "rosary" was officially used in 1597.
- The prayer that starts with "I believe in God..." is called the Creed.
- The prayer that starts with "Hail Holy Queen..." is called Salve Regina.
- The Fatima Prayer is the one prayed after Glory Be.

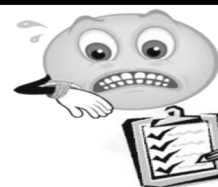

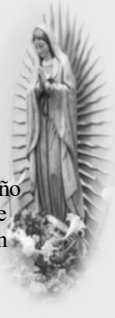
Hablar del peligro de los extraños

La idea de "peligro de un extraño" es a menudo un concepto demasiado amplio para que los niños la comprendan, ya que no todos los extraños son peligrosos y los niños siempre conocerán gente nueva y, en ocasiones, es posible que necesiten pedir ayuda a un extraño. En lugar de emitir una advertencia general, pruebe estos consejos para mantener seguros a los niños cuando están cerca de personas que no conocen. Si un adulto desconocido se les acerca, pídeles que le pregunten a uno de sus padres o a un adulto conocido y de confianza si puede entablar una conversación con esa

persona. Esto puede ser tan simple como una mirada rápida a los padres seguida de un asentimiento que indica que está bien interactuar. Usted mismo, como adulto, puede dar un buen ejemplo hablando primero con los padres de familia y luego con los niños bajo su cuidado.
