## Readings for the 11th Sunday of Ordinary Time

### First Reading

Ez 17:22-24

Thus says the Lord GOD:  
I, too, will take from the crest of the cedar,  
from its topmost branches tear off a tender shoot,  
and plant it on a high and lofty mountain;  
on the mountain heights of Israel I will plant it.  
It shall put forth branches and bear fruit,  
and become a majestic cedar.  
Birds of every kind shall dwell beneath it,  
every winged thing in the shade of its boughs.  
And all the trees of the field shall know  
that I, the LORD,  
bring low the high tree,  
lift high the lowly tree,  
wither up the green tree,  
and make the withered tree bloom.  
As I, the LORD, have spoken, so will I do.

### Second Reading

2 Cor 5:6-10

Brothers and sisters:

We are always courageous, although we know that while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord, for we walk by faith, not by sight. Yet we are courageous, and we would rather leave the body and go home to the Lord. Therefore, we aspire to please him, whether we are at home or away. For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each may receive recompense, according to what he did in the body, whether good or evil.

### Gospel

Mk 4:26-34

**Jesus said to the crowds:**

**"This is how it is with the kingdom of God;  
it is as if a man were to scatter seed on the land  
and would sleep and rise night and day  
and through it all the seed would sprout and  
grow, he knows not how.**

**Of its own accord the land yields fruit,  
first the blade, then the ear, then the full grain in  
the ear. And when the grain is ripe, he wields the  
sickle at once, for the harvest has come."**

## Lecturas para el 11º Domingo Ordinario

### Primera Lectura

Ez 17, 22-24

Esto dice el Señor Dios:

“Yo tomaré un renuevo de la copa de un gran cedro, de su más alta rama cortaré un retoño. Lo plantaré en la cima de un monte excelsa y sublime. Lo plantaré en la montaña más alta de Israel. Echará ramas, dará fruto y se convertirá en un cedro magnífico. En él anidarán toda clase de pájaros y descansarán al abrigo de sus ramas. Así, todos los árboles del campo sabrán que yo, el Señor, humillo los árboles altos y elevo los árboles pequeños; que seco los árboles lozanos y hago florecer los árboles secos. Yo, el Señor, lo he dicho y lo haré”.

### Segunda Lectura

2 Cor 5, 6-10

Hermanos: Siempre tenemos confianza, aunque sabemos que, mientras vivimos en el cuerpo, estamos desterrados, lejos del Señor. Caminamos guiados por la fe, sin ver todavía. Estamos, pues, llenos de confianza y preferimos salir de este cuerpo para vivir con el Señor.

Por eso procuramos agradarle, en el destierro o en la patria. Porque todos tendremos que comparecer ante el tribunal de Cristo, para recibir el premio o el castigo por lo que hayamos hecho en esta vida.

### Evangelio

Mc 4, 26-34

**En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a la multitud: “El Reino de Dios se parece a lo que sucede cuando un hombre siembra la semilla en la tierra: que pasan las noches y los días, y sin que él sepa cómo, la semilla germina y crece; y la tierra, por sí sola, va produciendo el fruto: primero los tallos, luego las espigas y después los granos en las espigas. Y cuando ya están maduros los granos, el hombre echa mano de la hoz, pues ha llegado el tiempo de la cosecha”.**

# Fiacre's Ordination as a Transitional Deacon May 29th

What does "transitional" imply? Following four years of college and three more years at the major seminary, a bishop only calls a man to become a transitional deacon if it is his intention that following one year as a deacon, he would then ordain this man to the priesthood.

For most transitional deacons, this year is a pastoral, liturgical and educational preparation period for the priesthood. When considering the sacrament of holy orders, there are three degrees of the sacrament: deacon, priest, bishop.

There are three promises made by the transitional deacon: to pray the Liturgy of the Hours, Obedience and Celibacy. The Liturgy of the Hours is also known as the "Breviary." This prayer, consisting of three psalms, a reading from Scripture and petitions, is a participation in the Perpetual Liturgy going on in Heaven. At the same time, through the Breviary, we sanctify the secular hours of the day and night on earth.

Both permanent and transitional deacons make a promise to obey their bishop and his successors. Unlike the permanent deacons, most of whom are married, transitional deacons promise their bishop to embrace celibacy. This means that they have to forego any exclusive relationships in order to love the Church with their whole being as if she were their spouse, the mother of their children. Permanent deacons are ordained and usually practice their diaconal ministry at their home parishes for an indefinite period of time, usually until their retirement.

Transitional deacons, on the other hand, are assigned by the bishop to a parish anywhere in the diocese, normally for a term of office, be it anywhere from three months to a year. Most transitional deacons have to return to the seminary for their fourth and final year of theology.
