

Readings for The Thirteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

Reading 1

2 Kgs 4:8-11, 14-16a

One day Elisha came to Shunem, where there was a woman of influence, who urged him to dine with her. Afterward, whenever he passed by, he used to stop there to dine. So she said to her husband, "I know that Elisha is a holy man of God. Since he visits us often, let us arrange a little room on the roof and furnish it for him with a bed, table, chair, and lamp, so that when he comes to us he can stay there." Sometime later Elisha arrived and stayed in the room overnight.

Later Elisha asked, "Can something be done for her?" His servant Gehazi answered, "Yes! She has no son, and her husband is getting on in years." Elisha said, "Call her." When the woman had been called and stood at the door, Elisha promised, "This time next year you will be fondling a baby son."

Reading 2

Rom 6:3-4, 8-11

Brothers and sisters: Are you unaware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were indeed buried with him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life. If, then, we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him. We know that Christ, raised from the dead, dies no more; death no longer has power over him. As to his death, he died to sin once and for all; as to his life, he lives for God. Consequently, you too must think of yourselves as dead to sin and living for God in Christ Jesus.

Gospel

Mt 10:37-42

Jesus said to his apostles: "Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me. Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it.

"Whoever receives you receives me, and whoever receives me receives the one who sent me. Whoever receives a prophet because he is a prophet will receive a prophet's reward, and whoever receives a righteous man because he is a righteous man will receive a righteous man's reward.

And whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones to drink because the little one is a disciple—amen, I say to you, he will surely not lose his reward."

WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Mass Celebrated Around the World

Question: Is the Catholic Mass really celebrated the same throughout the whole world?

Answer: One of the truisms of the Catholic Faith is that "wherever you go in the world, the Mass is the same." In fact, the answer to this question is both "yes" and "no." On the one hand, the essential elements of the Roman Rite are the same. The structure of the Mass as it is presented in the Roman Missal is consistent and this is one of the beauties of belonging to a liturgical tradition.

On the other hand, however, there are elements of celebrations that can vary depending on the country or even local region you might be in. For example, in certain parts of the world, certain feasts and solemnities are celebrated on different days (even here in the United States the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord can be celebrated on Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter or it may take the place of the Seventh Sunday of Easter, depending on what diocese you are in). Whether it is the use of certain liturgical colors, local celebrations of regional saints, special seasonal blessings of crops or produce, or the use of dance and processions all demonstrate a sort of organic variety that can exist even within our established liturgical tradition. While we always respect what is essential to the rite, such local variations and traditions are very much in keeping with the vision of liturgical renewal and adaption envisioned by the Second Vatican Council's Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy (nos. 37-40).

Lecturas para el XIII Domingo Ordinario

Primera Lectura

2 Reyes 4, 8-11. 14-16a

El criado le dijo: "Mira, no tiene hijos y su marido ya es un anciano". Entonces dijo Eliseo: "Llámala". El criado la llamó y ella, al llegar, se detuvo en la puerta. Eliseo le dijo: "El año que viene, por estas mismas fechas, tendrás un hijo en tus brazos".

Segunda Lectura

Rom 6, 3-4. 8-11

Hermanos: Todos los que hemos sido incorporados a Cristo Jesús por medio del bautismo, hemos sido incorporados a su muerte. En efecto, por el bautismo fuimos sepultados con él en su muerte, para que, así como Cristo resucitó de entre los muertos por la gloria del Padre, así también nosotros llevemos una vida nueva. Por lo tanto, si hemos muerto con Cristo, estamos seguros de que también viviremos con él; pues sabemos que Cristo, una vez resucitado de entre los muertos, ya nunca morirá. La muerte ya no tiene dominio sobre él, porque al morir, murió al pecado de una vez para siempre; y al resucitar, vive ahora para Dios. Lo mismo ustedes, considérense muertos al pecado y vivos para Dios en Cristo Jesús, Señor nuestro.

Evangelio

Mt 10, 37-42

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a sus apóstoles: El que ama a su padre o a su madre más que a mí, no es digno de mí; el que ama a su hijo o a su hija más que a mí, no es digno de mí; y el que no toma su cruz y me sigue, no es digno de mí. El que salve su vida la perderá y el que la pierda por mí, la salvará. Quien los recibe a ustedes me recibe a mí; y quien me recibe a mí, recibe al que me ha enviado.

El que recibe a un profeta por ser profeta, recibirá recompensa de profeta; el que recibe a un justo por ser justo, recibirá recompensa de justo. Quien diere, aunque no sea más que un vaso de agua fría a uno de estos pequeños, por ser discípulo mío, yo les aseguro que no perderá su recompensa".

¿POR QUÉ HACEMOS ESO? - VIDA CATÓLICA EXPLICA-DA

Misa Celebrada al rededor del Mundo

Pregunta: ¿Realmente la Misa católica se celebra igual en todo el mundo?

Respuesta: Una de las obviedades de la Fe Católica es que “dondequieras que vayas en el mundo, la Misa es la misma.” De hecho, la respuesta a esta pregunta es ambos “sí” y “no.” Por un lado, los elementos esenciales del Rito Romano son los mismos. La estructura de la Misa tal como se presenta en el Misal Romano es consistente y esta es una de las bellezas de pertenecer a una tradición litúrgica.

Sin embargo, por otro lado, hay elementos de celebraciones que pueden variar según el país o incluso la región local en la que se encuentre. Por ejemplo, en ciertas partes del mundo, ciertas fiestas y solemnidades se celebran en días diferentes (incluso aquí en los Estados Unidos, la Solemnidad de la Ascensión del Señor se puede celebrar el jueves de la Sexta Semana de Pascua o puede tomar el lugar del Séptimo Domingo de Pascua, dependiendo de la diócesis en la que se encuentre). Ya sea el uso de ciertos colores litúrgicos, las celebraciones locales de santos regionales, las bendiciones especiales de temporada de cultivos o productos, o el uso de danzas y procesiones, todo demuestra una especie de variedad orgánica que puede existir incluso dentro de nuestra tradición litúrgica establecida. Si bien siempre respectamos lo que es esencial para el rito, tales variaciones y tradiciones locales están muy de acuerdo con la visión de renovación y adaptación litúrgica prevista por la Constitución del Concilio Vaticano II sobre la Sagrada Liturgia (núms. 37-40). ©LPi




Please plan on joining them for pancakes, eggs, sausage, juice and coffee 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Sunday morning, July 9th.



