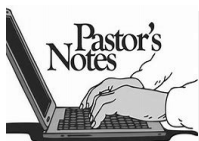

Solemnity of Most Holy Trinity June 14, 2020

The Mysteries of Our Catholic Christian Faith

If there is one thing that the COVID-19 pandemic has made us do, it's to spend more time in prayer. I know that this is true for me. Every day, even in the middle of the night, I would talk to God about my thoughts, fears, and innermost desires.

In my prayers, I would talk to him as a Father, who takes care of our needs and protects us. After all, he created us, and he wishes nothing to harm us. I would also speak to him as the Son, Jesus, who redeemed us and showed us the Father's will. And then, of course, I would call on him as the Holy Spirit to ask for the gifts of consolation, peace, faith, courage, wisdom, and strength.

Last Sunday, we celebrated the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. We remembered that we have a Triune God and a Trinitarian faith. At the beginning of every prayer, we invoke the name of God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

It's how God chose to reveal himself to us in the Scriptures. He is One God but Three Persons—one of the mysteries of our faith. We may not be able to explain this dogma thoroughly. Still, it is how God communicated himself to us throughout the history of salvation.

This Sunday, we're celebrating another mystery of our Catholic faith: our belief in the presence of Christ in Body and Blood. Although for other Christians, this is incomprehensible, we claim to understand it as Christ's way of making himself present to us and continuously offering himself as the bread of eternal life.

Fr. John Kavanaugh, SJ says it right: "Corpus Christi, the body and blood of Christ, is the marriage of God and us. This union took place not only in the Incarnation; it is re-enacted in our Eucharists, whereby God in Christ is made one with our very flesh, the living sign that God is with and for us now and always." (*The Word Embodied: Meditations on the Sunday Scriptures* Orbis Books, Maryknoll, New York (1998), pp. 69-71)

Now that we have reopened our Church, we thank God for this opportunity to go to Communion again. Although the pandemic has not allowed us to drink from the cup to receive the Blood of Christ, this does not mean that we don't receive the person of Jesus fully. The host, what we call

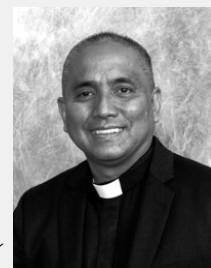

the bread, and the chalice of the Precious Blood, each in themselves, contain the totality of the glorified, resurrected Jesus Christ, body, blood, soul, and divinity.

We pray that this pandemic will end soon so that we can all come back to Mass to the Mysteries of our Faith that brings wholeness, peace, healing, strength, and wisdom.

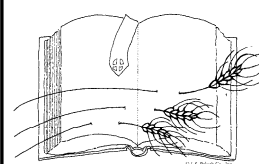

Did You Know?

Teach children everyday actions to reduce the spread of germs.

It is appropriate to frequently remind your children about ways to avoid or reduce the spread of germs and to start practicing at home. Among the tips are: Stay away from people who are coughing, sneezing or sick. Remind them to cough or sneeze into a tissue or their elbow, then throw the tissue into the trash. Get the children into a handwashing habit. Teach them to wash their hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after blowing their nose, coughing, or sneezing; going to the bathroom; and before eating or preparing food. If soap and water are not available, teach them to use hand sanitizer. Hand sanitizer should contain at least 60% alcohol. Supervise young children when they use hand sanitizer to prevent swallowing alcohol.
