# FROM PASTOR'S DESK



Greetings!

Here we are on the first week of Advent already. If you're like me, it's hard to connect the sequence of events in 2020 and the year before. Perhaps, the almost two years of the Covid-19 pandemic have clouded our minds and memory.

Nevertheless, we thank God that many of us have survived the pandemic. Our churches are open and getting back to their normal course, albeit many parishioners still need to return. Indeed, it will be our ongoing challenge to fill our church pews again Sunday after Sunday. We pray that Advent and Christmas will motivate people to attend Mass and participate in the liturgical and pastoral life of the Church.

The Advent liturgies are antidotes to secularism and apathy toward faith and church life. They remind us to stay awake and pay attention to the temporal state of our lives — that we live in between two comings: the first, being the birth of the Messiah, our Lord, Jesus Christ, and his life, death, and resurrection; and the second, the fulfillment of God's Kingdom when Christ will come "in a cloud with power and great glory."

Advent urges us to be vigilant and to prepare ourselves for the Second Coming of Christ. It's the theme of the Gospel (Luke 21:28, 34-36) in this First Sunday of Advent.

*"Beware that your hearts do not become drowsy from carousing and drunkenness and the anxieties of daily life and that the day catches you by surprise like a trap. For that day will assault everyone who lives on the face of the earth. Be vigilant at all times and pray that you have the strength to escape tribulations that are imminent and to stand before the Son of Man."*

For this reason, we come to Church to worship and support one another in prayer and love. We cannot escape the tribulations of present life alone. We need one another for encouragement, wisdom, and strength. And we need the Sacraments and the guidance of our pastors and fellow Christians.

As St. Paul tells us in this Sunday's Second Reading:

*"Brothers and Sisters: May the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, just as we have for you, so as to strengthen your hearts, to be blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all his holy ones."*

But Church life is not just about the parish, our families, homes, and our friends. It's also about the world we live in — how to bring justice and peace to it. It's about promoting the dignity of every person and promoting fraternity among all people.

In *Fratelli Tutti*: Encyclical On Fraternity and Social Friendship, Pope Francis reminds us of the critical role of a community in making positive changes in our society. He states:

*"Here we have a splendid secret that shows us how to dream and to turn life into a wonderful adventure. No one can face life in isolation....We need a community that supports and helps us, in which we can help one another to keep looking ahead. How important it is to dream together...."*

*By ourselves, we risk seeing mirages, things that are not there. Dreams, on the other hand, are built together. Let us dream, then, as a single human family, as fellow travelers sharing the same flesh, as children of the same earth which is our common home, each of us bringing the richness of his or her beliefs and convictions, each one of us with his or her own voice, brothers and sisters all."*

Let's invite our families, friends, and other people to **"Come Home for Christmas"** and be part of Incarnation Church that aspires to be a welcoming, loving, caring, joyful, and faith-filled community.

As we enter into the holiday season, where many of us will spend time with extended family and friends, parents should remember to pay attention to their children's comfort levels, especially when it comes to physical affection. We want our children to be kind and considerate, so it is tempting to ask them to give hugs and kisses to family members and friends. But when children are nervous or shy, or just do not want to, it is important to honor their personal boundaries — and it teaches them a great lesson about consent over who interacts with them and their bodies. 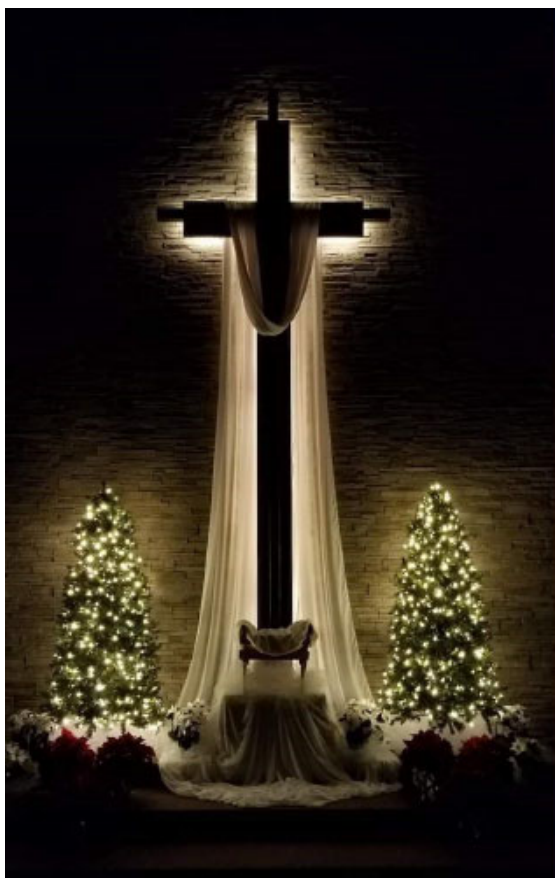
## PARISH NEWS & EVENTS
