FROM PASTOR'S DESK



GRATEFUL FOR A JOYOUS, LOVING, AND FAITH-FILLED COMMUNITY!

Greetings on this Father's Day and Parish Carnival! It's fiesta time, a weekend of merry-making with rides, food, drinks, entertainment, prizes, and most of all, the love and care of our parish and school community.

We're fortunate to belong to this parish that aspires to be welcoming, loving, joyful, and faith-filled. And so, we're having this carnival to show our support to our parish and to give thanks to God as a Catholic community that God has blessed tremendously with the power and gifts of the Holy Spirit. We thank God for his spiritual nourishment as we celebrate weekday and Sunday Masses, receive the Eucharist, hear God's Word, and participate and serve in the other Sacraments and varied ministries.

We give thanks to God for being able to overcome the challenges, restrictions, and hurdles of the pandemic. Thank God that we can finally hold this parish carnival after three years!

We have an amazing parish filled with many generous and caring people, untiring volunteers, and lay leaders in different ministries and councils. 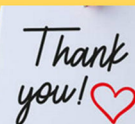

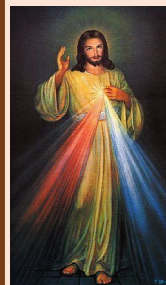

UPDATE ON ADAM VENCES

First and foremost, the Vences Family has asked to express to the parish their deep gratitude for the support they have received—prayers, gifts and other assistance.

Because of other complications related to Adan's cancer, he had to undergo 4 procedures on his colon and kidneys which had to delay his chemotherapy treatment. He has recovered well from the procedures and is resuming the chemotherapy this weekend.

As you recall, Adan was diagnosed with Rhabdomyosarcoma (RMS). Rhabdomyosarcoma is a rare type of cancer that forms in soft tissue.

Adan will most likely be hospitalized for the remainder of the year. As a community let us to continue our prayers for Adan and his family as they go through this challenging time.

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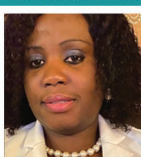
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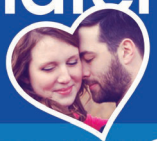
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
