## **THEOLOGY I & II (Freshmen & Sophomores)**

You will need all books and materials on the first day of class, Aug. 14th, 2023.

- 1) Revelation of Christ in Scripture (Textbook only), Spirit of Truth
- 2) Life of Christ Lectio Divina Journal: No need to order; Purchase at School for \$16.00 (Lumen Ecclesiae Press/Openlight Media), Clearly labeled with first and last name.
- **3) 3 Subject Notebook** (Theology Notebook), Clearly labeled with first and last name. Can continue using Freshman Theology Notebook
- **4) 1 Subject Notebook** (Lectio Divina Journal), Clearly labeled with first and last name. Can continue using Freshman Theology Notebook
- **5) 3-Ring Binder with 1-3 pocket dividers for all handouts/materials** (1-2 inch recommended), Clearly labeled with first and last name.
