## New in 2025-2026: Greater System-Wide Consistency

Alignment of the student experience at all grade levels has been a priority since Xavier Catholic Schools became a school system in 2024. Dress code was an area that was in need of alignment and consistency across all XCS buildings. Starting with the 2025-2026 school year, the dress code below adheres to an established philosophy while presenting Xavier Catholic Schools as a single, unified school system with a common mission: To form disciples unafraid to follow Jesus Christ.

We also understand that bringing the dress codes of our schools into greater alignment is something that impacts all K-12 XCS families. Therefore, to give families the appropriate amount of time to plan, the dress codes in place for the 2024-2025 school year in each individual building will also be grandfathered in for the 2025-2026 school year.

ST. MATTHEW - Red and Yellow/Gold ST. PIUS X - Burgundy and Gray

REGIS - Red and Yellow/Gold

XAVIER HIGH SCHOOL - Shirts/Sweaters/Vests/Cardigans available only through Land's End (Polos with the Xavier Catholic Schools logo must be purchased through Land's End or the Saints Shop at Xavier High School in XCS colors (with embroidered logo) - same as in the past (LandsEnd.com - School Code is 900139700) May also be worn by elementary and middle school students
