The Queen of Heaven prayer is traditionally said or sung after the night prayer during easter, before going to sleep. The prayer also replaces the Angelus prayer during Easter, being prayed at 6 am, 12 pm, and 6 pm. The Regina invites us to celebrate and rejoice in union with Mary and the Church over the Lord's resurrection. The prayer then leads us to ask God to grant us everlasting life with the help of the intercession of the Virgin Mary.



Queen of heaven, rejoice, alleluia! For He whom thou didst merit to bear, alleluia!

Has risen, as He said, alleluia! Pray for us to God, alleluia!

Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia! For the Lord has truly risen, alleluia!

Let us pray.

O God, who through the resurrection of Thy Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, didst vouchsafe to give joy to the world; grant, we beseech Thee, that through His Mother, the Virgin Mary, we may obtain the joys of everlasting life. Through the same Christ our Lord.

Father, in every generation you provide ministers of Christ and the Church.




Bless us with priestly vocations so that we can continue to be a truly Eucharistic Church, strengthened in our discipleship of Jesus Christ, your Only Son.

# Saint of The Week



St. Joseph has two feast days, the first being on March 19—Joseph, the Husband of Mary. The second is May 1—Joseph, the Worker.

"Saint Joseph is a man of great spirit. He is great in faith, not because he speaks his own words, but above all because he listens to the words of the Living God. He listens in silence. And his heart ceaselessly perseveres in the readiness to accept the Truth contained in the word of the Living God," Pope John Paul II had once said.

There is very little about the life of Joseph in Scripture but still, we know that he was the chaste husband of Mary, the foster father of Jesus, a carpenter and a man who was not wealthy. We also know that he came from the royal lineage of King David. We can see from his actions in scripture that Joseph was a compassionate man, and obedient to the will of God. He also loved Mary and Jesus and wanted to protect and provide for them.

Since Joseph does not appear in Jesus' public life, at his death, or resurrection, many historians believe Joseph had probably died before Jesus entered public ministry. Joseph is the patron of many things, including the universal Church, fathers, the dying and social justice.


