Msgr. Fabijan Svalina,Bishop Coadjutor of Srijem

He was born on November 7th, 1971, in Dakovo. Ordained for priest on June 29th, 1997, and appointed for bishop of Srijem on October 7th, 2021, and was consecrated on November 21th, 2021 in cathedral of St. Demetrius.

Diocese of Srijem is one of the oldest christian communities in the world. That church has given many martyrs, including Pollius the lector, and Irenaeus of Sirmium (d. 309). In the 4th century it served as the metropolitan see for western Illyricum.

Destroyed by the Avars (582), the city was rebuilt around the Oriental monastery of St. Demetrius and was called Dmitrovica, while Sirmium (Croatian Sriem) became the name of the region between the Sava and the Danube Rivers.

The apostolic nuncio in Croatia, announced on June 18 2008., that Pope Benedict XVI has re-established the Diocese of Srijem.



From the first letter to Serapion by Saint Athanasius, Bishop



We acknowledge the Trinity, holy and perfect, to consist of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. In this Trinity there is no intrusion of any alien element or of anything from outside, nor is the Trinity a blend of creative and created being. It is a wholly creative and energizing reality, self-consistent and undivided in its active power, for the Father makes all things through the Word and in the Holy Spirit, and in this way the unity of the holy Trinity is preserved.

Accordingly, in the Church, one God is preached, one God who is above all things and through all things and in all things. God is above all things as Father, for he is principle and source; he is through all things through the Word; and he is in all things in the Holy Spirit.

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all. For grace and the gift of the Trinity are given by the Father through the Son in the Holy Spirit. Just as grace is given from the Father through the Son, so there could be no communication of the gift to us except in the Holy Spirit. But when we share in the Spirit, we possess the love of the Father, the grace of the Son and the fellowship of the Spirit himself.




